



TRADITIONAL GLASS
MARBLES

160 MARBLES
3 SIZES



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a circle 3 feet in diameter with chalk if on pavement. You can make a circle with string if indoors. You can even draw a circle in the dirt if in the yard!
2. Choose your shooter marble. The shooter is one of the 7 larger marbles included.
3. Put the other marbles in the center of the circle to play. More marbles means a longer game!
4. The youngest player goes first. While kneeling outside the ring each player, in order, flicks their shooter marble out of their fist with the thumb. The player is trying to hit and move as many marbles as possible out of the ring.
5. Any marbles knocked completely out of the ring are kept by the shooter. If the shooter did hit marbles out of the ring they get another turn.
6. If the player does not knock any marbles out of the ring, leave the shooter marble in the ring until your next turn. The next player in order then takes their turn.
7. Continue until the circle is empty.
8. The person with the most marbles at the end of the game is the winner!
