#### What Else You Will Need

- LOW TEMPERATURA GLUE GUN: you can easily find one on Amazon, Walmart, Target, Hobby Lobby and your local store.
- **EXACTO KNIFE:** not really necessary, however your size walls may have a few extra centimeters. If this happens, just remove them with your Exacto knife.



#### How To Assemble The Number Shape

1. Unfold and lay out the number base on a flat surface.



 Before using any glue, preassemble the segments by placing the side walls to the number base. Please take a look at the section ► "How To Match Side Walls To The Number Base" in the next pages!



Please make sure you understand the correct placement of each segment before proceeding to use the glue.

 Use your low temperature glue gun to glue the side walls along the edge of the number base.





Your kit may have straight walls, walls with rounded edges, or a combination of the two walls.

If you have bendable walls, you simply need to gently press the foam board to open the scored lines and curve the segment.

- 4. If there are excess side walls, use your cutter to remove them.
- 5. Insert the back stand into the base. After inserting the stand, you might add some glue around the dents to ensure extra stability.





Then insert all of it into the number base

#### How To Fill The Number Shape With Balloons

- 1. Lay your number sculpture on a flat surface (for example, on the floor). This way, it will be easier to add all the balloons to the shape.
- 2. Blow up your balloons to 3/4 full you may use a pump for faster results.
- 3. Place your round balloons inside the sculpture attaching them to the foamboard with a glue dot. Keep going until the number shape is full. You may place glue dots between balloons as well to ensure a fuller look.
- 4. If the number sculpture has gaps, blow up more balloons (depending on the size of the gap) and place them in the gap using glue dots. This almost creates a second layer of balloons.
