Dear Shareholder,

We are pleased to inform you that the Board of Directors at their Meeting held on Thursday, May 25, 2023 has recommended a Final Dividend of Rs. 3.30/- per equity share (33% per Equity Share of Face Value of Rs.10/- each) for the financial year 2022-2023. The dividend, as recommended by the Board, if declared at the ensuing Annual General Meeting, will be paid to eligible shareholders within 30 days from the date of its declaration either in electronic or in physical form at the end of the book closure date.

As you are aware that as per the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended by the Finance Act, 2020, dividends paid or distributed by a Company after April 01, 2020 shall be taxable in the hands of the shareholders. The Company shall therefore be required to deduct tax at source at the time of making the payment of Dividend at the applicable rates as per the provisions of the Act.

The TDS rate may vary depending on the residential status of the shareholder and the documents submitted to the Company in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

The TDS for various categories of shareholders along with required documents are provided in Table 1 and 2 below:

- a) Recording of the valid Permanent Account Number (PAN) for the registered Folio/DP id-Client Id is mandatory. In absence of valid PAN, tax will be deducted at a prescribed rate of 20% as per Section 206AA of the Act.
- b) Shareholders holding shares under multiple accounts and having single PAN, may note that, higher of the tax as applicable to them in which shares held under a PAN will be considered on their entire holding in different accounts.
- c) For Shareholders who are identified as "Specified Persons" under Sec 206AB of the Act, higher tax rate as applicable would be deducted if:

SUBMISSION OF TAX RELATED DOCUMENTS:

Kindly note that the duly completed and signed documents as mentioned in the Table 1 and 2 above are required to be submitted to the Company / Registrar at the e-mail ID <u>companysecretary@elegantmarbles.com</u> or gamare@unisec.in on or before July 24, 2023 in order to enable the Company to determine and deduct appropriate TDS / withholding tax rate. Incomplete and/or unsigned forms and declarations will not be considered by the Company / Registrar, for the aforesaid purpose. No communication/documents on the tax determination / deduction shall be considered post 11:59 PM (IST) of July 24, 2023. No claim shall lie against the Company for such taxes deducted.

The Company will arrange to e-mail a soft copy of the TDS certificate at the shareholders' registered e-mail ID in due course, post payment of the said Final Dividend. Shareholders will also be able to see the credit of TDS in Form 26AS, which can be downloaded from their e-filing account at <u>https://www.incometax.gov.in/iec/foportal</u>
