




Australia has some amazing places! One of these is the Torres Strait. You can find the Torres Strait off the northern tip of Australia between Cape York and Papua New Guinea.





The Torres Strait is a narrow sea with lots of islands. It connects the Indian Ocean (Arafura Sea) in the west with the Pacific Ocean (Coral Sea) in the east. The Spanish navigator, Torres, sailed through the strait in 1606. This is how it got its name.



Torres Strait Islanders are First Nations people. They came from islands in the north thousands of years ago. The sea level was much lower back then. They could walk between New Guinea and Australia. When the sea level rose, the Torres Strait islands were formed.



People live on 17 of these islands. They also live on the mainland. Torres Strait Islanders have different histories and cultures to Aboriginal Australians. They also have different languages. Their culture is very special too! They call it Ailan Kastom.
