#### **Understanding Texts**

- Build background knowledge with a rich book introduction. Tell students
  that Vesak is a celebration of Buddha's birthday; lotus flowers are
  special and that people give gifts to the monks. Look through the text
  and find images of monks, lotus flowers and Buddha. \*UnT4, UnT5
- After reading, talk about some of the things that people do during the Vesak celebration. Make a list to display. \*UnT4, UnT5
- Explain to students how the lotus flowers provided stepping stones for Buddha to walk on. \*UnT4, UnT5
- Vesak celebrates Buddha's birthday. Talk with students about how they celebrate their birthday. \*UnT4

  other words that start with the fl blend such as flow, fly, flip and fling.
