

The author has had a role in the diagnosis, and often the


treatment, of many of the cases.

This increases the authenticity of the book. Historical anecdotes about the diseases, and the people who described them, are liberally sprinkled throughout the book.

Many of the diseases are presented with photographs of the medical records of the cases used by the doctors to define the diseases. Most textbooks show only the high magnification view of the organisms. This book shows how the pathologist examines



the slides to 'find' the organisms. Diseases that occur in specific areas of the world where they are endemic are illustrated. Examples of these diseases when they occur in travellers or immigrants in a non-endemic environment. Under these circumstances, the medical practitioners of first contact have had no experience of these diseases, and therefore have difficulty in making a correct diagnosis.
