Understanding Texts

- Before reading, build background knowledge with a rich book introduction.
 Ensure students know what packaging is; what foods are packaged and why and that a lot of packaging is made from plastic. *UnT4, UnT5
- After reading, have students recall the reasons that food is packaged for freshness, safety and containment. Use examples from the text. Encourage students to think of other examples of food for each category such as biscuits for freshness and strawberries for safety. *UnT4, UnT5
- After reading, discuss the different ways plastic damages the environment.
 Make links to other texts that students may have read that discuss the environmental impact of plastics. *UnT4, UnT5

Phonic Knowledge and Word Recognition + Phonological Awareness

- Locate the words food and good. Notice each word has the same medial vowel pattern. Say each word and hear the difference in the way each sounds. Make word strings for each such as food, mood and brood and good, hood and stood.

- Locate the words bananas, apples and oranges. Have students notice the s on the end that denotes plural. Read each word with and without the s. *PKW5
