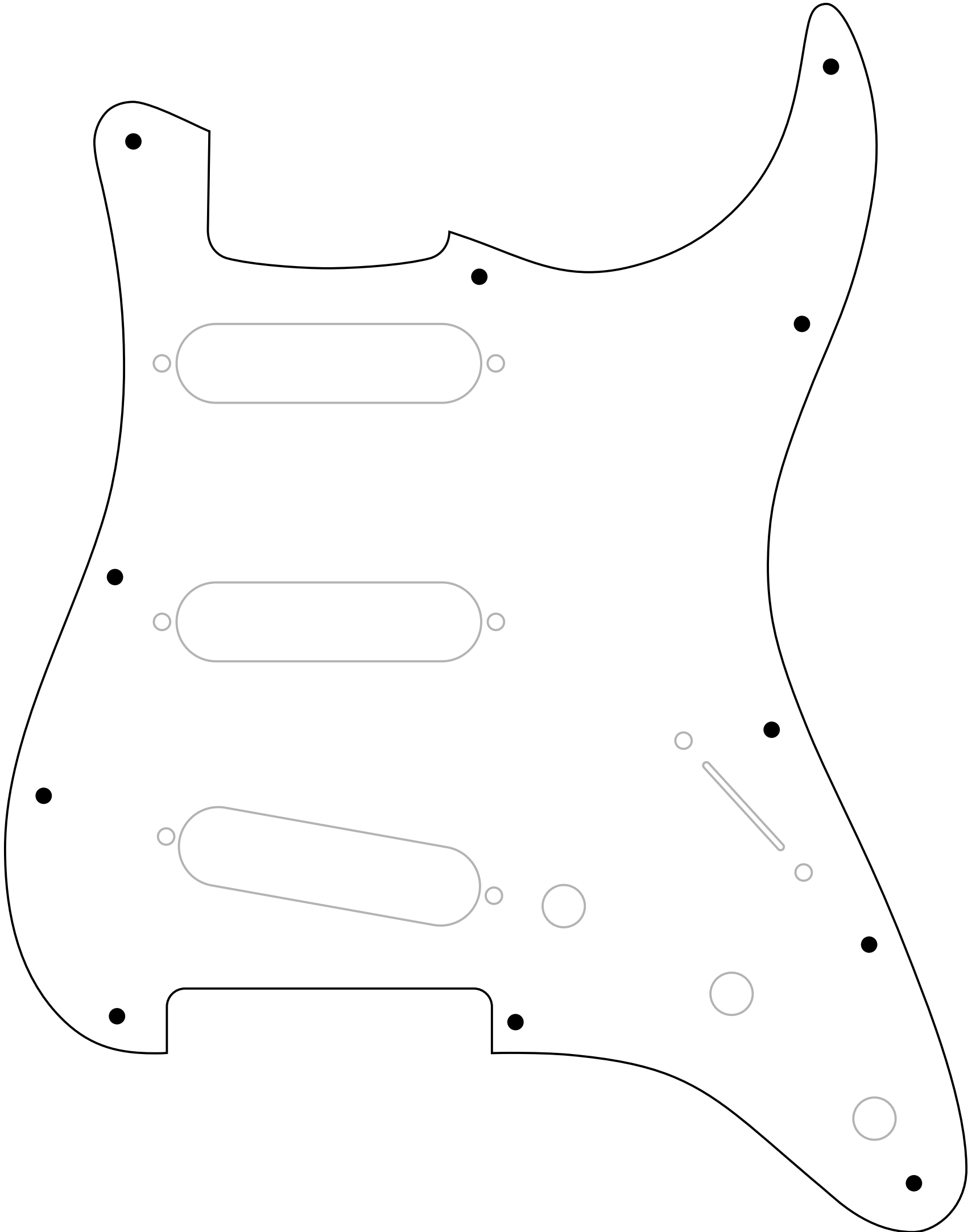
MOUNTING PATTERN: 11-HOLE (STANDARD)

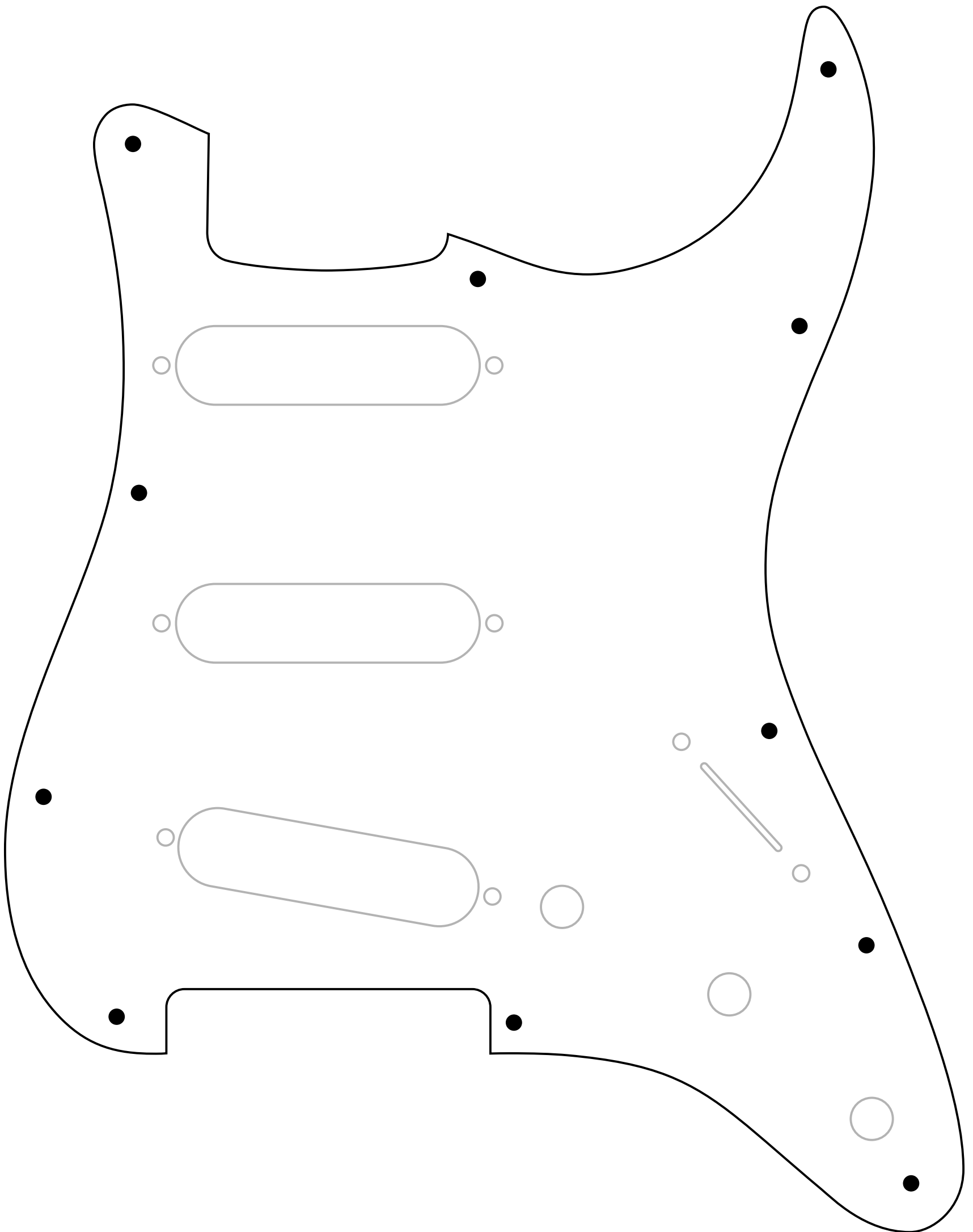
MOUNTING PATTERN: 11-HOLE (VINTAGE)

Uncommon configuration, using a modified 11-hole pattern around the perimeter of the guard (shown in solid black dots).
Used from 1959 to 1963 and in some reissues.



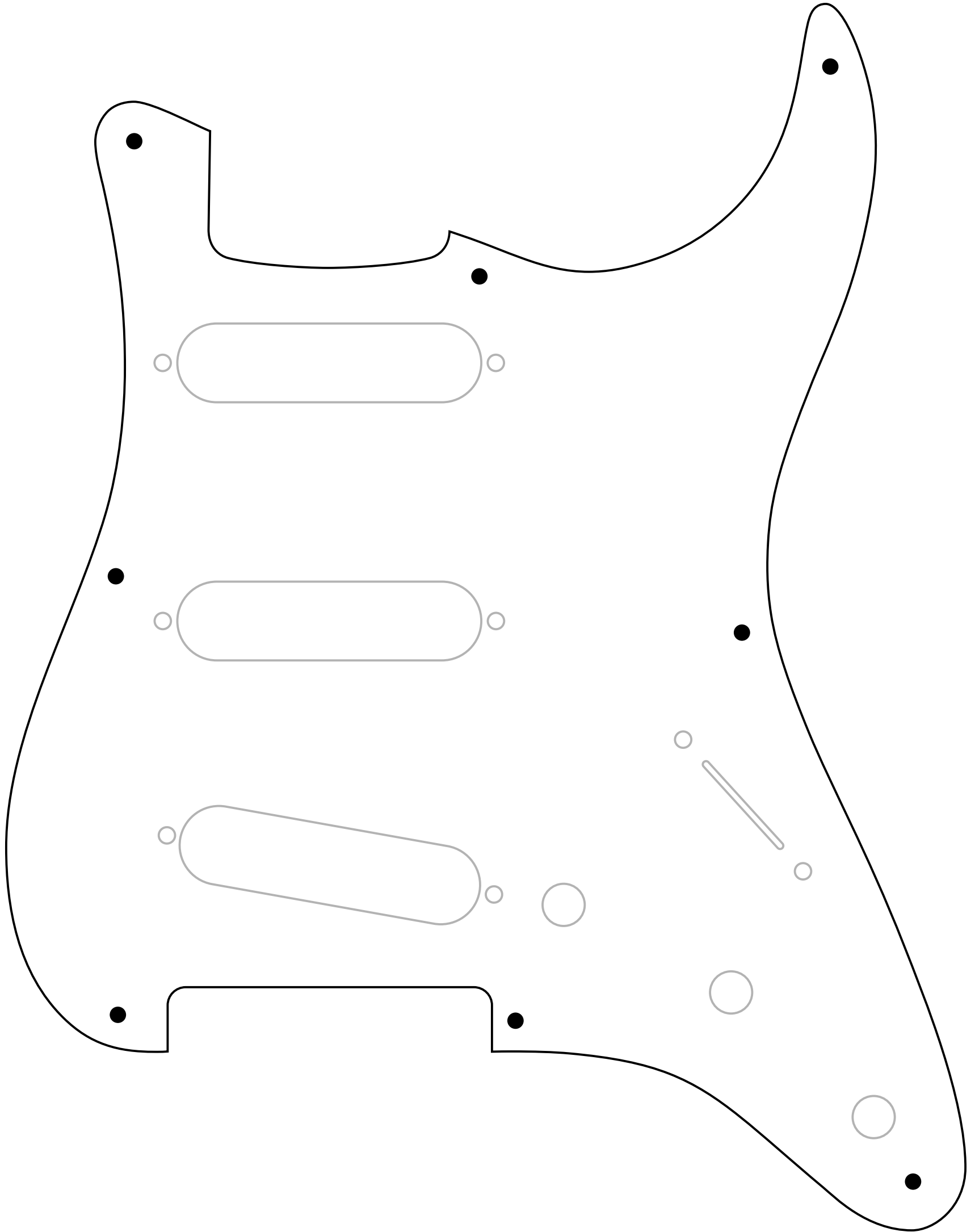

Uncommon mounting configuration using 8-holes around the perimeter of the guard (shown in solid black dots).
Used from 1954 to 1959 and in some reissues.
