

ZONEPRO™ GRAPHIC SPECIFICATIONS

*ARTWORK FILE SPECIFICATIONS IN DETAIL

- A 1.5" Bleed Area (on all sides = 3" total) beyond the TRIM
- A 7" Safe Area on the canister/lead side from the TRIM
- A 3" Safe Area on the opposite side/tail of the spool from the TRIM
- A 3" Safe Area on the top from the TRIM
- A 3" Safe Area on the bottom from the TRIM

**SAFETY AREA AND CANISTER ORIENTATION CONSIDERATIONS

If you plan to have your canister on the LEFT

- Please make sure that 7" of your safety area is on the LEFT side from the TRIM line.
- [This is necessary to allow for the extra fabric that will spool inside the canister.](#)

If you plan to have your canister on the RIGHT

- Please make sure that 7" of your safety area is on the RIGHT side from the TRIM line.
- [This is necessary to allow for the extra fabric that will spool inside the canister that will not be seen when the ZonePro is installed.](#)

8 FOOT BANNERS: TRIM 96" X 38" SAFETY 86" X 32" ** BLEED 99" X 41"
10 FOOT BANNERS: TRIM 120" X 38" SAFETY 110" X 32" ** BLEED 123" X 41"
12 FOOT BANNERS: TRIM 144" X 38" SAFETY 134" X 32" ** BLEED 147" X 41"

RESOLUTION

MAKE SURE YOUR FILE IS HIGH RESOLUTION

- Finished artwork with photographs and/or full-color backgrounds, must be a minimum of 180 and a maximum of 300 DPI at their final print size.

ACCEPTABLE FILE FORMATS

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

Microsoft® Word®, Excel®, or PowerPoint® files.

PROGRAM	FILE EXTENSION	SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS
 Acrobat	.pdf	Must be high resolution with fonts embedded.
 InDesign	.indd or .idml	Images embedded and fonts changed to outlines or send a packaged file with fonts and images.
 Illustrator	.ai or .eps	Vector artwork. Images embedded and fonts changed to outlines or send a packaged file with fonts and images.
 Photoshop	.psd .tiff .jpeg .eps	Raster artwork. Must be built in CMYK color space.

COLOR

- For printing, **CMYK** colors are used to achieve the best representation of your artwork. All RGB colors must be checked and converted to CMYK.

FONTS & LINKS

If creating artwork in Adobe® InDesign® or Illustrator® there are two options when supplying fonts.

- **Change fonts to outlines.** This prevents fonts defaulting or being substituted throughout the layout and production process. *REMEMBER: if creating outlines, text is no longer editable.*
- **Package the fonts.** From InDesign or Illustrator select File → Package → Check "Copy Fonts" and submit PC format TTF fonts or OTF fonts with your artwork.
