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Birdhouse Woodworking Kit

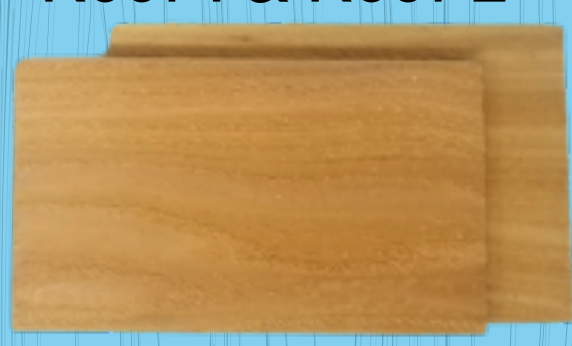
1 Front [2 holes] & 1 Back



1 Bottom Piece



Roof 1 & Roof 2



2 Side Pieces



*notice Roof 1 is 1/2 inch shorter width than Roof 2

3 Bird Feeder Pieces



Cedar Window Set

1 Chimney & 1 Perch



4 Wood Slices

Cedar Shingles



Sandpaper



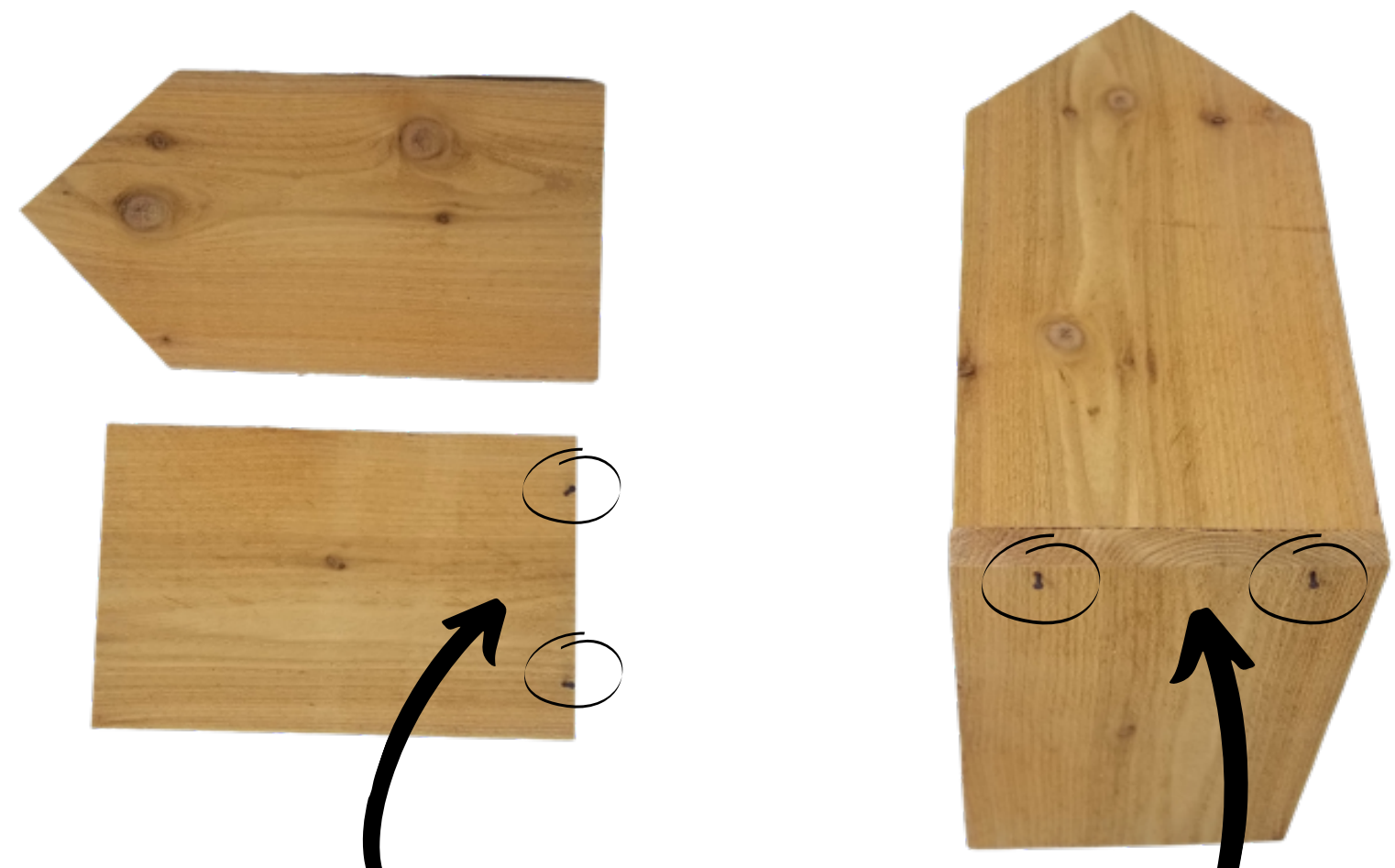
Silicone Glue

STEP 1



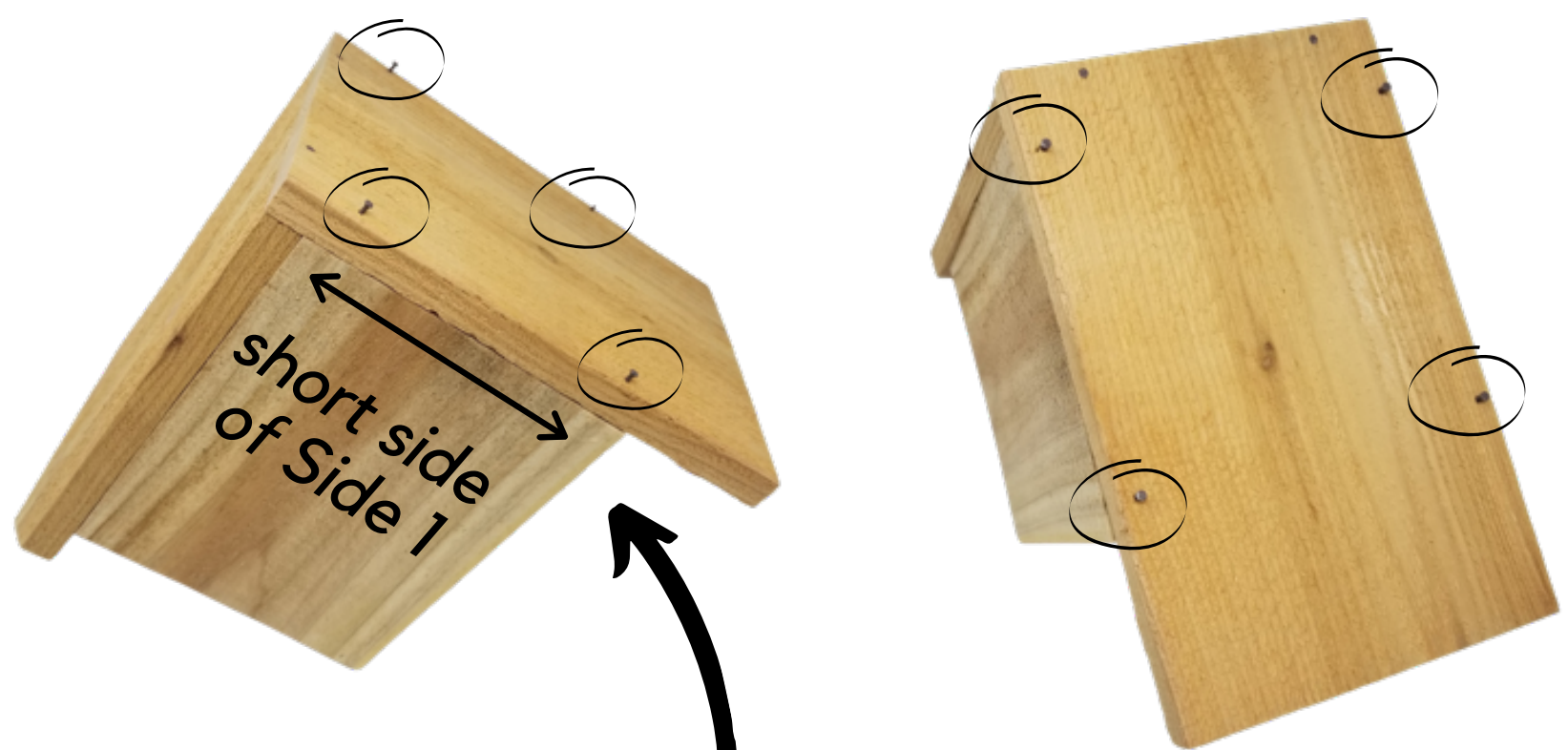
Sand each piece of wood. Look for the grain of the wood and sand WITH the direction of the grain.

STEP 2



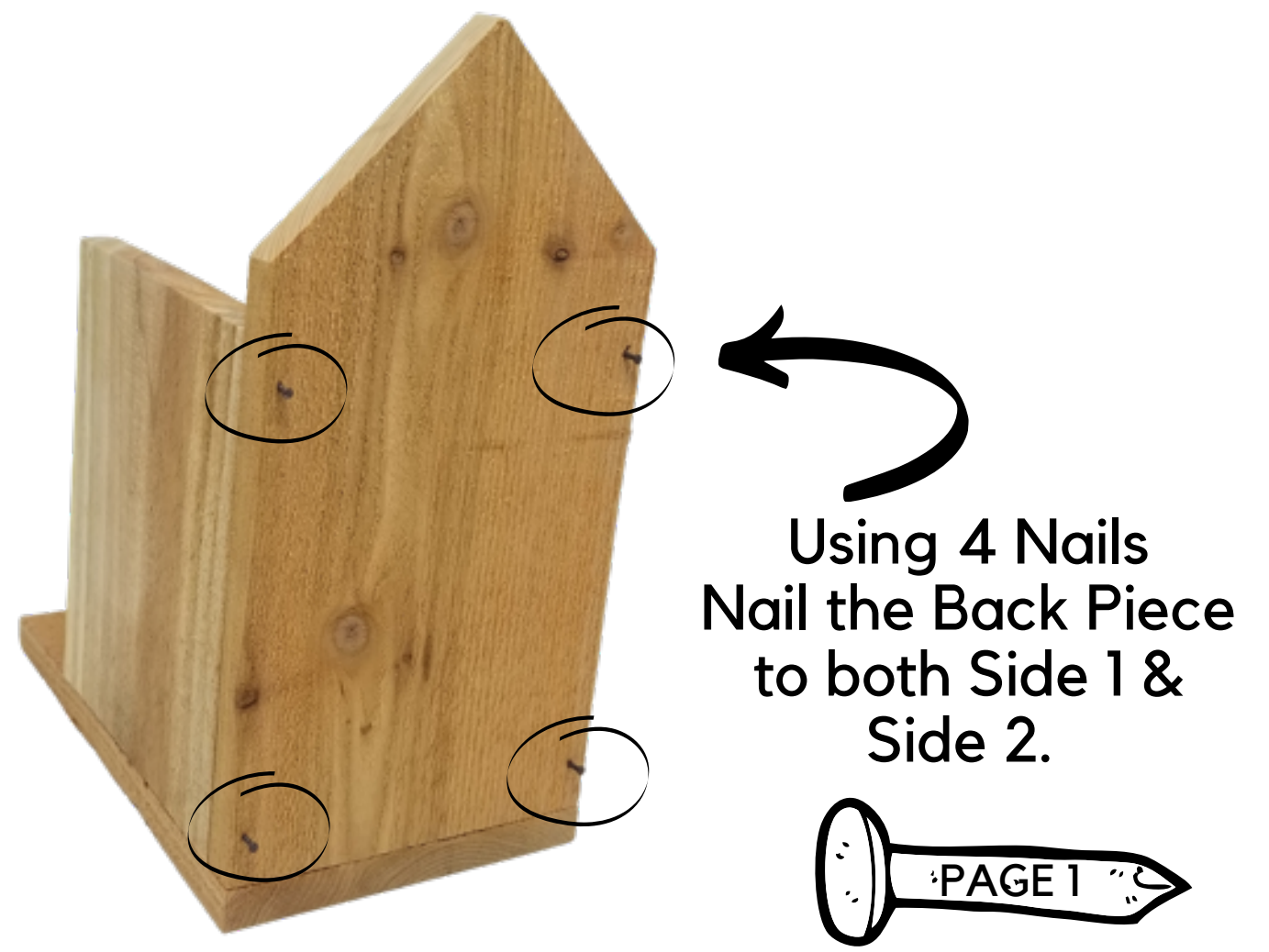
Using 2 Nails Nail the Bottom piece to the Back piece.

STEP 3



Nail the Bottom to the short side of Side 1 using 2 Nails. Repeat with Side 2.

STEP 4



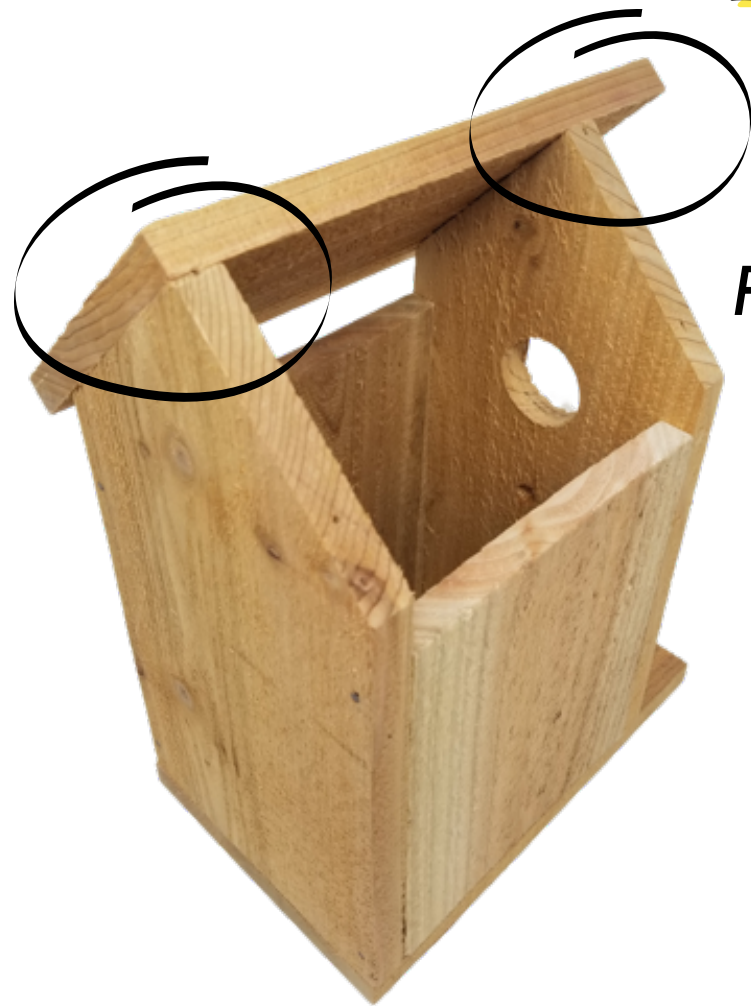
Using 4 Nails Nail the Back Piece to both Side 1 & Side 2.

STEP 5



Using 4 Nails Nail on the front piece.

STEP 6



*Line up the short side of Roof 1 with the Back. **Make sure the overhang is over the Front.**



Using 4 Nails Nail Roof 1 to the frame.



Using 4 Nails attach Roof 2.

STEP 7



Glue the 3 Bird Feeder pieces and insert the Perch. *Tap lightly with hammer. *Let sit 1 hour before proceeding.

STEP 8



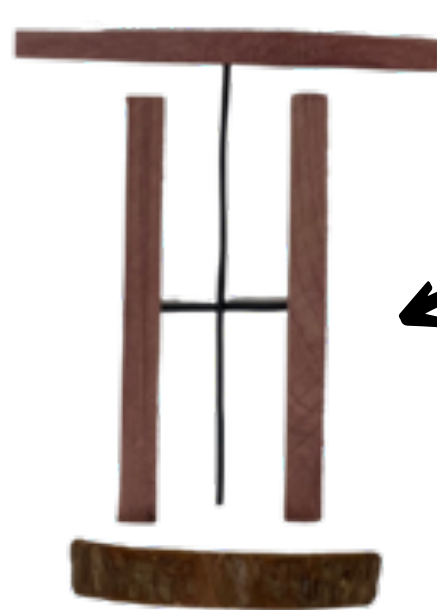
Lay the birdhouse on it's back and glue on the 4 Wood Slices Get creative!!!

STEP 9

Cedar Window Kit



FIRST... Using the short wire make an "H" shape with 2 cedar pieces. **SECOND...** Using the long wire make a "T" shape with 1 cedar piece.



Your windows are now ready to be glued.

THIRD... On each side of the birdhouse glue the "H" in place, followed by the "T".

Last connect the wood disc to the "T" and Glue in place.



*TIP... Use the rubber band to help hold the windows in place.

STEP 10

Our Shaker Shingled roof has 4 rows of overlapping Cedar Shingles.

Starting at the bottom of **Roof 1** begin gluing on the 1st row of shingles moving from left to right.

Make sure to leave roughly a 1/4 inch overhang on the front and bottom of the roof.

Shingles come in different thicknesses. To achieve the shaker style look try alternating the thickness of the pieces.

Take your time and most importantly...
HAVE FUN!



Begin the 2nd row of Shingles by slightly overlapping the first row of shingles.

TIP... *Don't try to be perfect, the best shaker shingle roofs are IMPERFECT!*

Repeat with the 3rd row of shingles.



Begin the 4th row at the very top of **Roof 1**, being careful not to overlap the edge of **Roof 2**.

After completing **Roof 1**... Wait 1 hour.

Starting at the bottom front **LEFT** of **Roof 2** begin gluing on the 1st row of shingles moving from left to right.

*** Begin your **FINAL** row at the **Top LEFT** with roughly a 1/4 inch overhang over **Roof 2**.



STEP 11

Glue on the Chimney.



STEP 12

Hand screw the 2 Eyehooks into the roof.
