Our Policy

Employees of Nine Grp International LLP are encouraged to report any instance of suspected Modern Slavery to either the relevant authorities in the country of work, or a superior within the company.

Nine Grp International will hold no accountability to workers who report, nor will seek legal council against the reporter.

In instances where the reported is outside the company, Nine Grp will endeavor to make the relevant authorities aware of the situation.

In instances where the reported is within the company, Nine Grp will investigate every report thoroughly for evidence and will raise a query with authorities suitably.
