

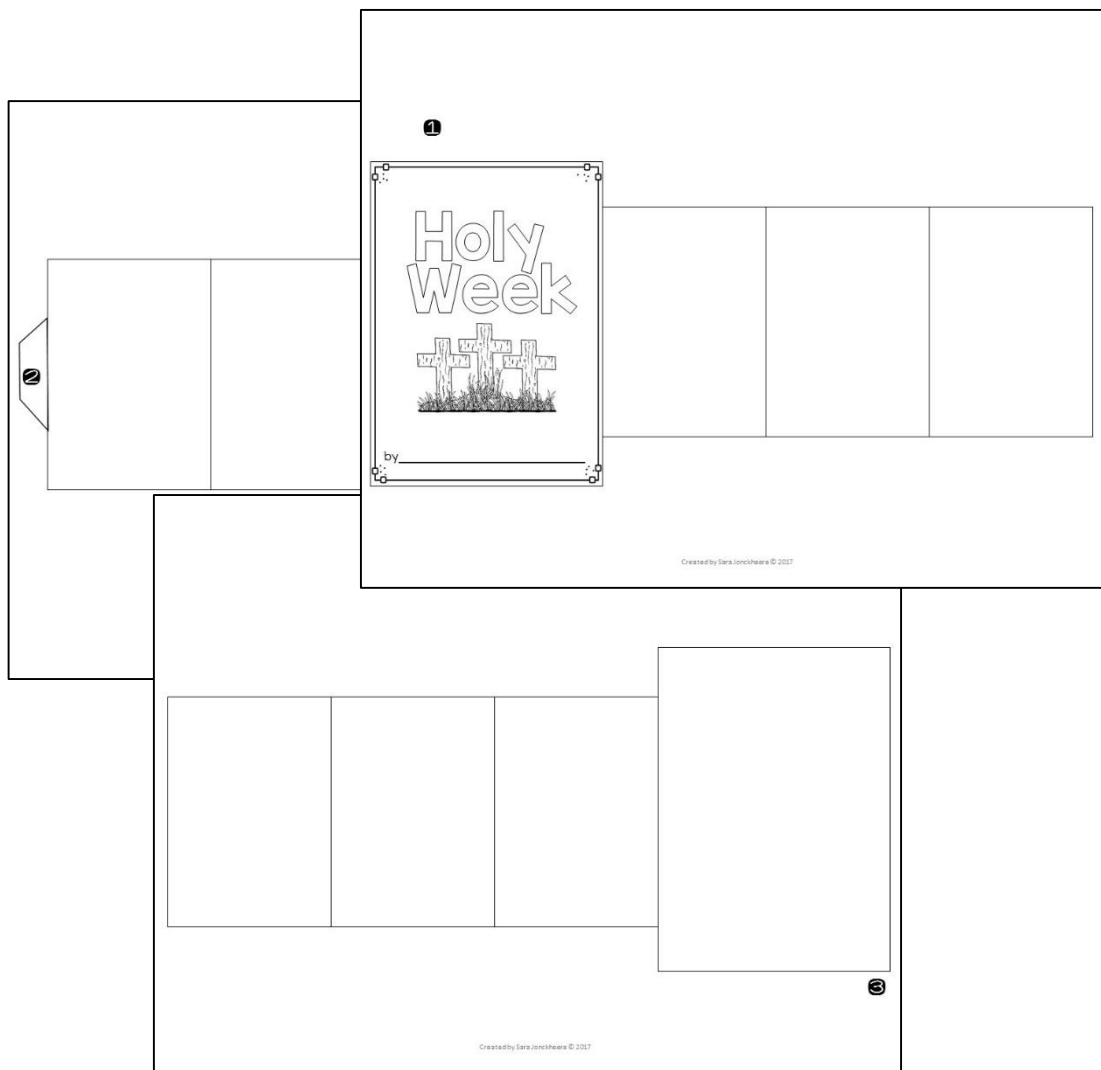

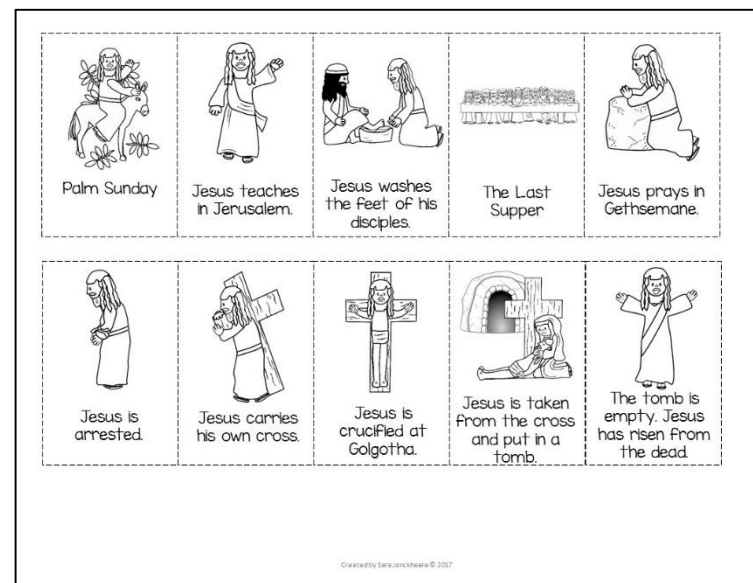

This original version takes a little bit longer to assemble and creates a smaller accordion style book. Ideal for older students or if you have more time for this activity.

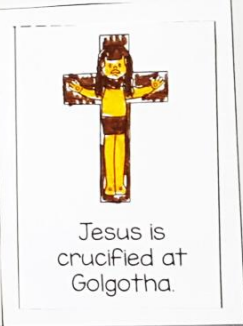
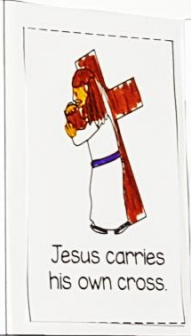
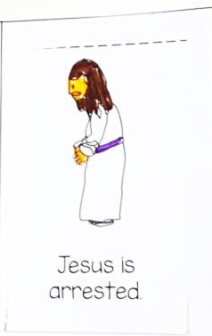
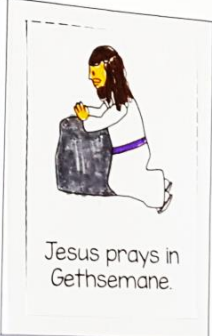


Cut, tape and fold the mini book



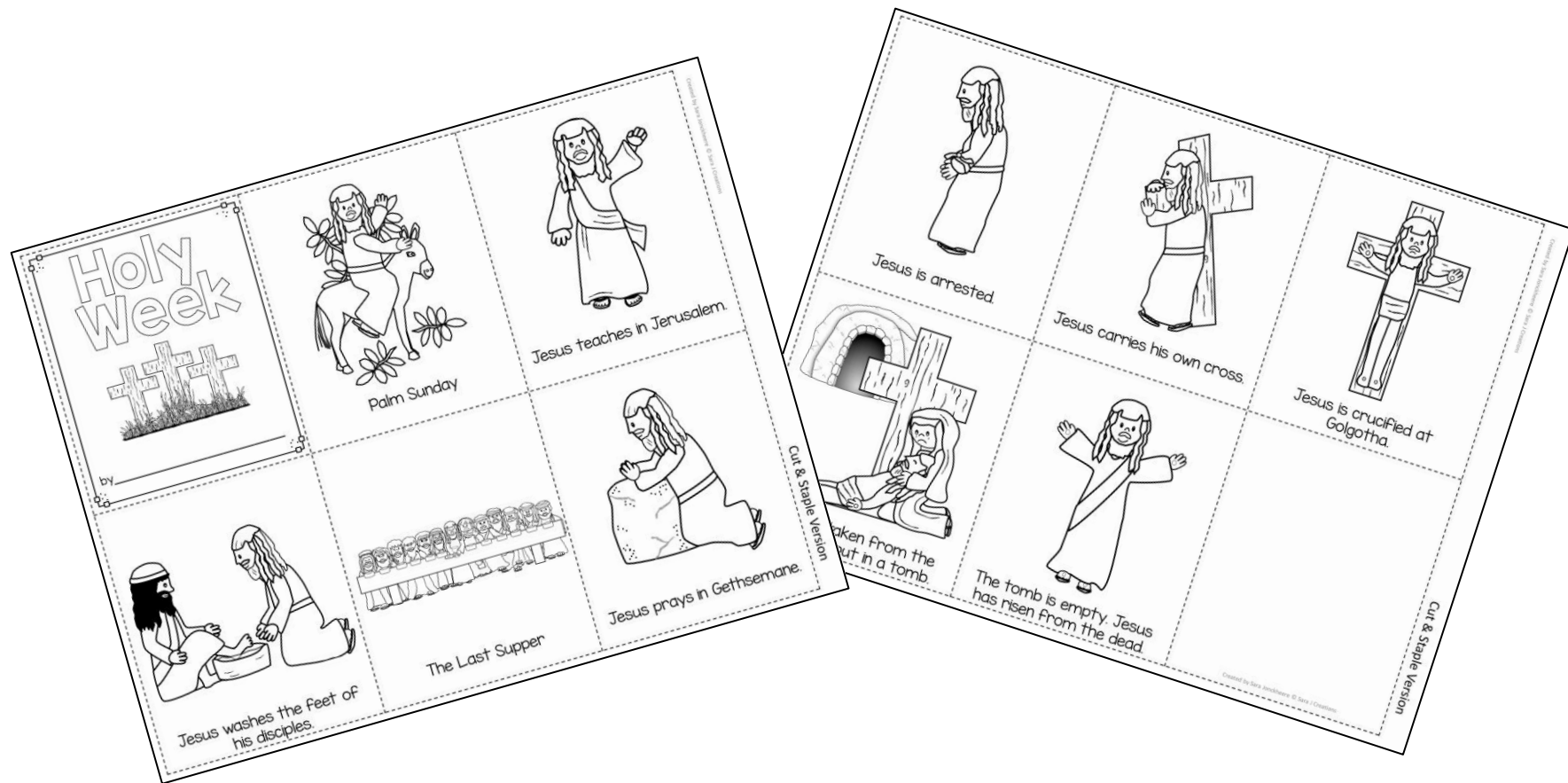
Color, cut, glue the pictures into the book

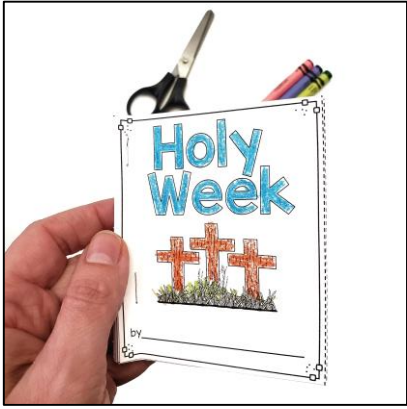
CUT & STAPLE VERSION OF THE BOOK

Additional Information	
Palm Sunday	Jesus enters Jerusalem on a donkey and colt. The crowd spread out their cloaks on the road and cut palm branches down and spread them on the road.
Jesus teaches in Jerusalem	Before the Feast of Passover, Jesus took off his outer garments, wrapped a towel around his waist and bent down to wash the feet of his disciples. He did this to give them a model to follow so that what he did for them, they would go out and do for others.
Jesus washes the feet of his disciples.	Jesus institutes the Eucharist by his words and actions at the Last Supper. He tells his apostles "to take and eat, this is my body" as he breaks the bread. And shares wine telling them "to drink his blood of the covenant which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins."
The Last Supper	Jesus prayed while his disciples continued to fall asleep instead of stay awake as he prayed.
Jesus prays in Gethsemane.	Judas kisses Jesus as a sign to the chief priests, elders and crowd that it is he who should be arrested. They arrest him and take him to Calaphas, the high priest.
Jesus is arrested.	(For more details on this step, follow the Stations of the Cross)
Jesus carries his own cross.	(For more details on this step, follow the Stations of the Cross)
Jesus is crucified at Golgotha.	Joseph from Arimathea went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. He wrapped the body in linen and placed him in a tomb. He rolled a huge stone across the entrance.
Jesus is taken down from the cross and put in a tomb.	Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to the tomb to find an angel of the Lord at the tomb with the stone rolled away. The angel told them He had been raised from the dead.
The tomb is empty. Jesus has risen from the dead.
