# COVER

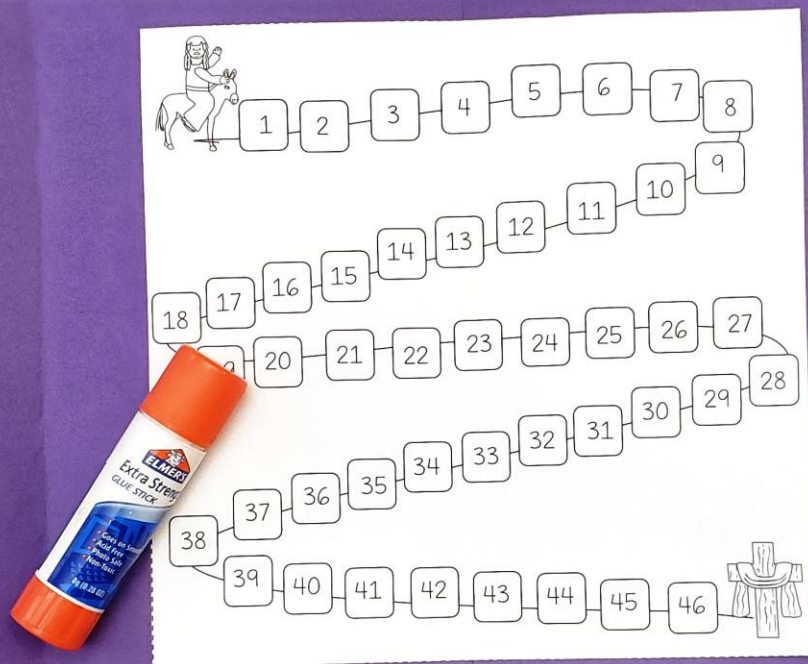
TWO DIFFERENT OPTIONS FOR THE COVER

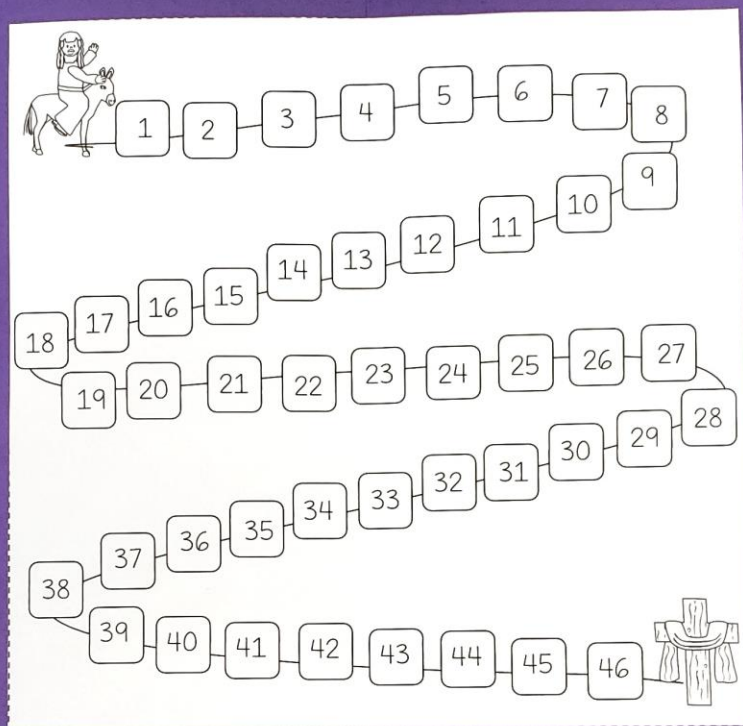
# COUNTDOWN

## Using the Lapbook

After you've decided which version you want to use, print out the pages you need. Cut them apart and color. It helps to color before you do any gluing.

### COVER

Open file folder. Fold the left side to the center fold and crease.

Fold the right side to the center fold and crease.

Glue cover pages onto the outside flaps. Fill in name and year.

### COUNTDOWN

Pick the countdown you want to use and glue it to the middle section near the top.

Students will color a square each day to countdown to Easter.

### LENTEN PROMISE

Stack the Ash Wednesday and Lenten Promise pages in order by height and staple at the top to make a flip book.

Have students read about Ash Wednesday.

## Directions for Use

Decide which Lent lapbook pages you want to use. I created 2 different versions for some of the sections.

Choice 1 - Cover page. Choose from "My Lent Lapbook" or "My Lenten Journey"

Choice 2 - Countdown to Lent. I've included a 40 days version since we often hear the term "40 Days of Lent." This would exclude Sundays.

Or there is a version that has 46 days to color in. This would include each day from Ash Wednesday to Easter.

Choice 3 - The Flip books for the events of Holy Week. There is a simplified version called "Read, Write, Draw" where students will read/listen to a scripture passage, fill in the blanks to finish a quote from that passage, and then draw what happened.

The more challenging version is called "Bible, Retell, Connection" Students will read the passage, retell by writing and drawing what happened, and then fill out the connection page that answers a question about the passage by either putting themselves in the story or comparing to modern day.

- Supplies Needed
- Lapbook Pages
  - File Folders
  - Glue
  - Scissors
  - Crayons/markers
  - Stapler
  - Hole Punch (optional)
  - Book Ring (optional)
  - Bible (The Catholic Children's Bible preferred)



## Using the Lapbook (cont. 2)

### STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Color and cut apart the 14 Stations of the Cross cards. You could staple these into a mini book or hole punch the top left corner and use a metal book ring to clip them together.

Lay the envelope face down and fold on the dotted lines. Put glue on the two flaps and fold up the page with the words to make the pocket. Fold the top flap down (DO NOT GLUE THE FLAP DOWN). Allow this to completely dry before sticking the cards in it. To make this envelope more durable, you could also use tape to reinforce the sides since students will hopefully be pulling the cards out of this envelope regularly.

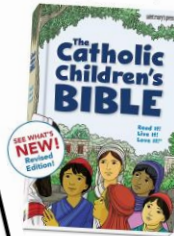
Glue the back of the envelope to the bottom right corner of the center section. Slide the stations cards inside.

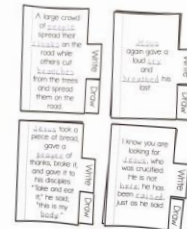
## Using the Lapbook (cont. 3)

### HOLY WEEK MINI BOOKS (EASIER VERSION) CONT

Glue Palm Sunday and Holy Thursday on the left flap. Glue Good Friday and Easter Sunday on the right flap.



These fill in the blanks are designed to be used with The Catholic Children's Bible by Saint Mary's Press. Other translations could be used, they just wouldn't be word for word.



### HOLY WEEK MINI BOOKS (HARDER VERSION)

Read the scripture passage. Students will write and draw what happened in that on the middle page. On the last page they will fill out the connection page by asking the question. This will be things like connecting it to their own life, a modern day to the story in the Bible, etc.

Work on the left side. Then glue the back page of the books to the outer students can still open and reference these.
