**What is All Saints' Day?**

On November 1, The Catholic Church celebrates all saints – those who we know and celebrate throughout the year on their feast days, and those who are in heaven and only known to God.


This is a day that gives us great hope, that people who lived on earth just like us are in heaven with God. We can be in heaven one day, too!



All Saints' Day is considered a Holy Day of Obligation. A Holy Day of Obligation is every Sunday plus a few additional days throughout the year in which we celebrate the great things God has done for us through Jesus and the saints.


We must go to Mass on these days to celebrate and ponder these special holy events and people.

When Holy Days of Obligation are celebrated and when they can be moved to a different date vary by country with the approval of bishops and the Holy Father. Check each year to see the requirements where you live.

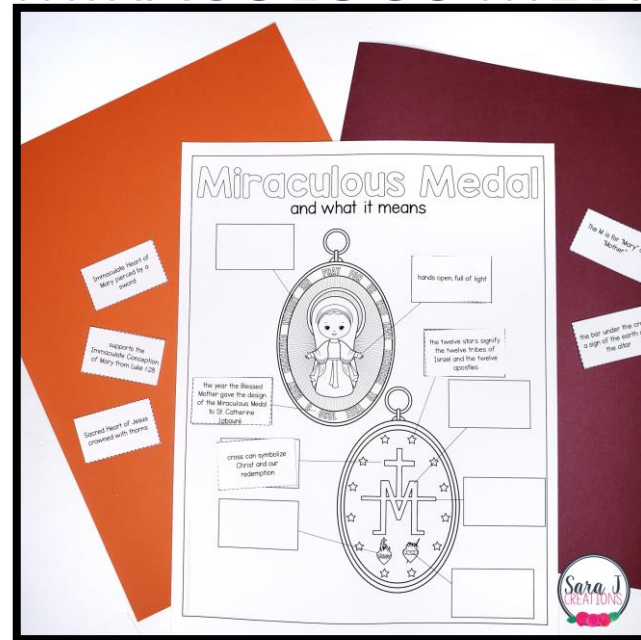

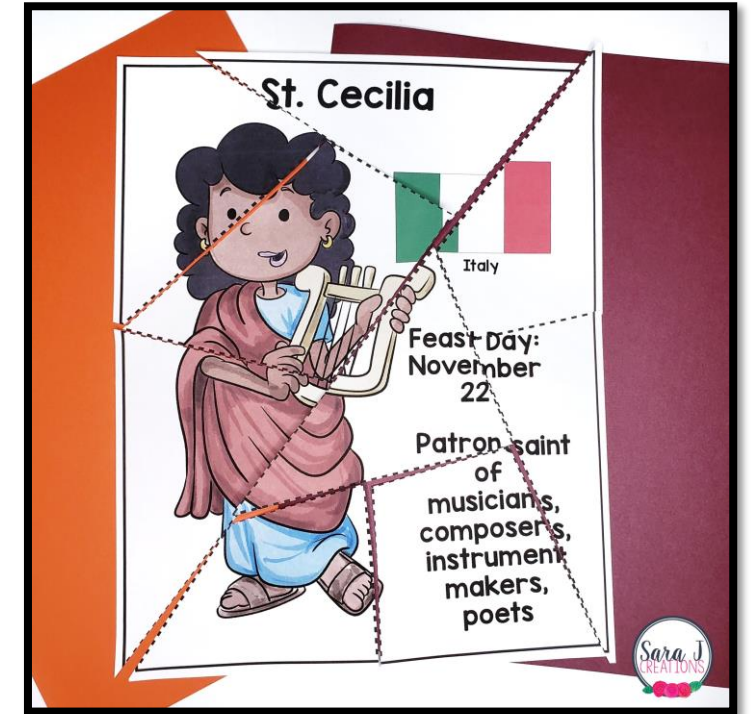

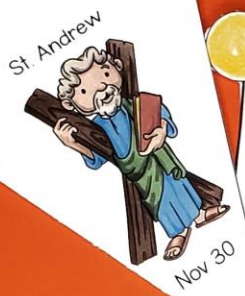
