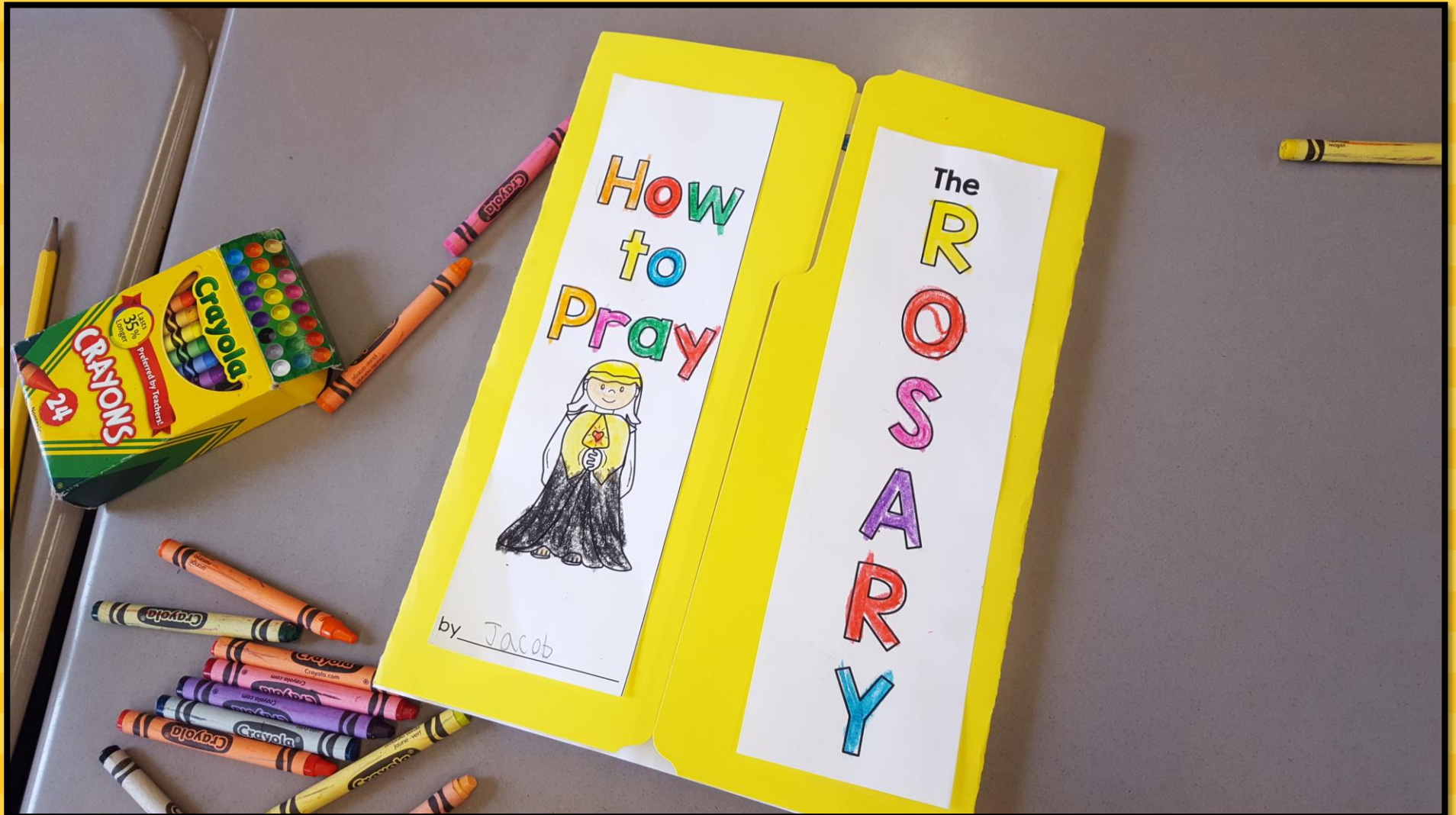

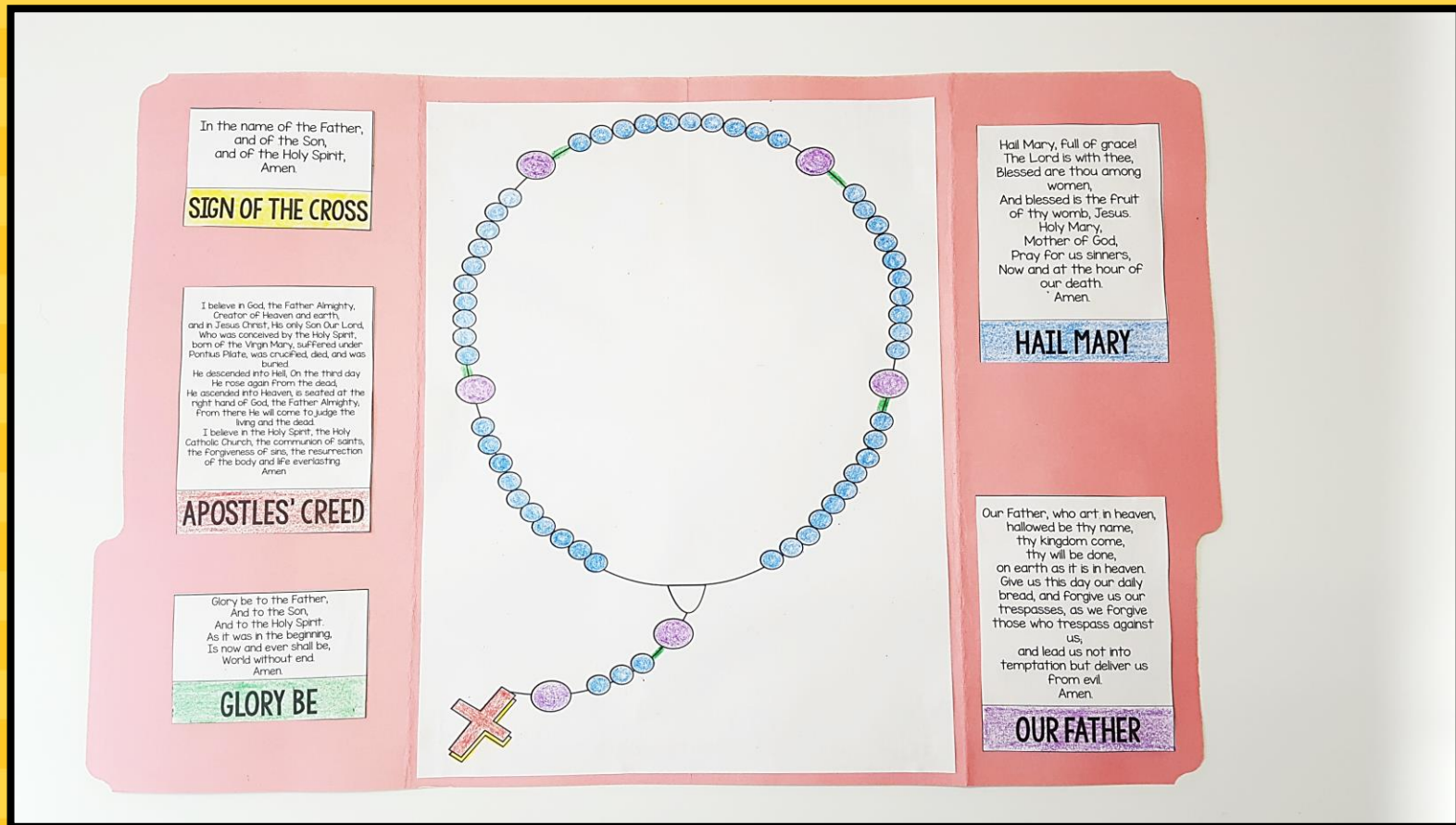

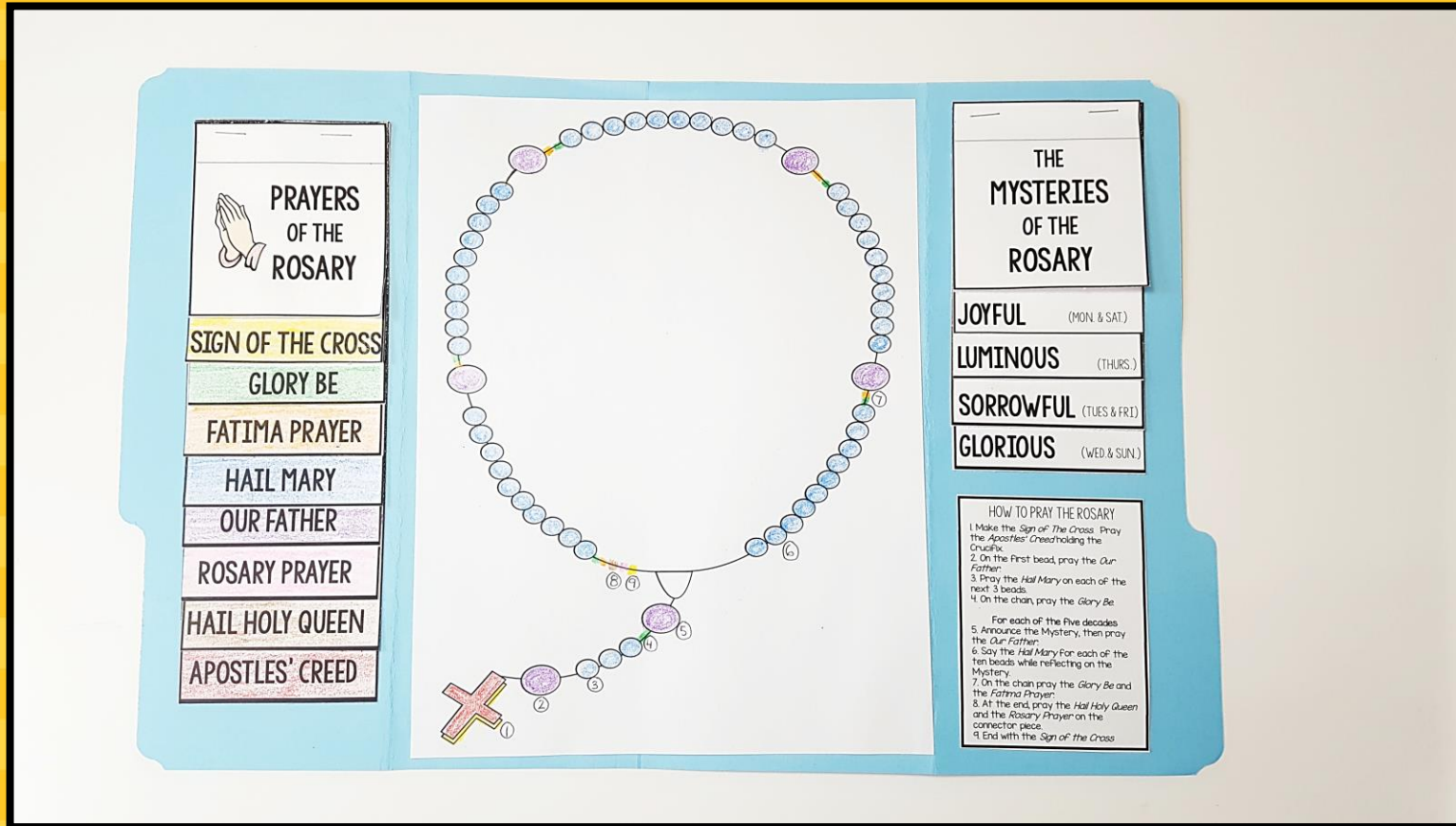

## Directions for Use

Decide which rosary lapbook you want to use. I created 2 different versions. The first one is a more simplified version for younger students just learning the rosary. The focus is Hail Mary and Our Father. As you can see, I also included a few other prayers but I've left



The second option is 1 needed prayers in a flip format and step by step Rosary.

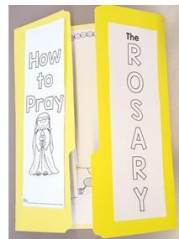
\*Note: I've tried to keep the prayers as close together as possible so you have the least amount of cutting to do.

(Tip: Color first and then glue or wait until the glue is completely dried before coloring.)

\*Note: I've tried to keep the prayers as close together as possible so you have the least amount of cutting to do. For the Flipbook pages of Sign of the Cross and Glory Be, I've include two sets of prayers on one page to save paper.

(Tip: Color first and then glue or wait until the glue is completely dried before coloring.)

1. Open File Folder: Fold the left side to the center fold and crease. Fold the right side to the center fold and crease.

2. Glue cover pages onto the outside flaps.

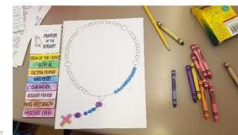


3. Glue Rosary to the inside center.

4. Cut the prayers out and line them up according to height. Staple twice at the top. Glue just the back page down to the File Folder so that the pages still lift up.

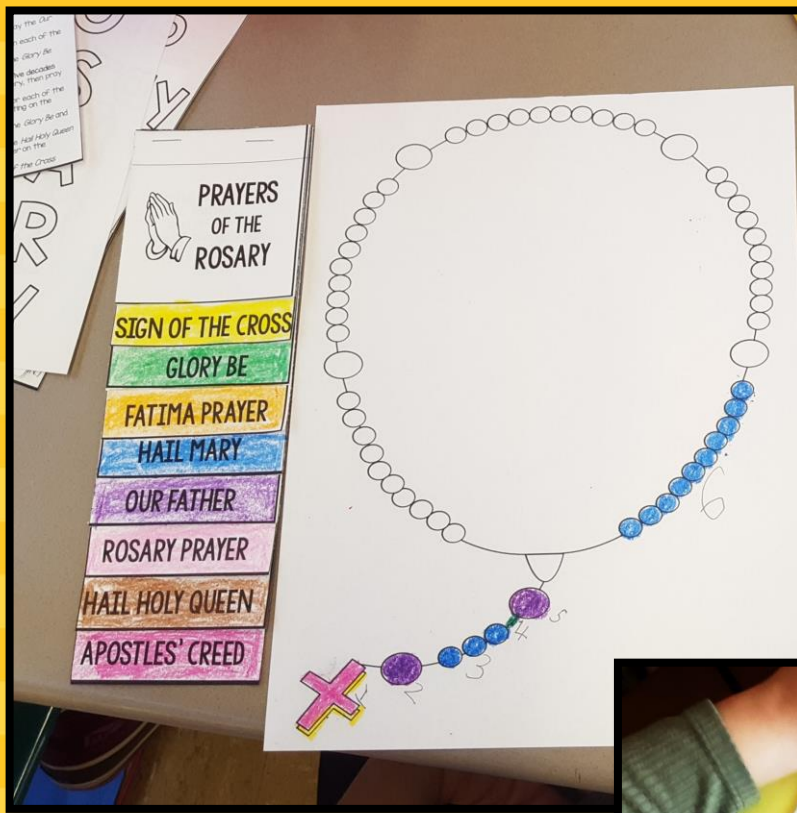
5. Do the same thing with the mysteries pages on the right flap and glue the how to pray the rosary card underneath.

5. Color the prayer names. Use those same colors to color the corresponding bead on the rosary. We did this as a whole group and went bead by bead and talked about what color it would be. We also added a number to correspond with the "How to Pray the Rosary" card.
