Joseph was a carpenter and the foster father of Jesus. He listened to God and did what he was told, and he helped Mary to raise Jesus.

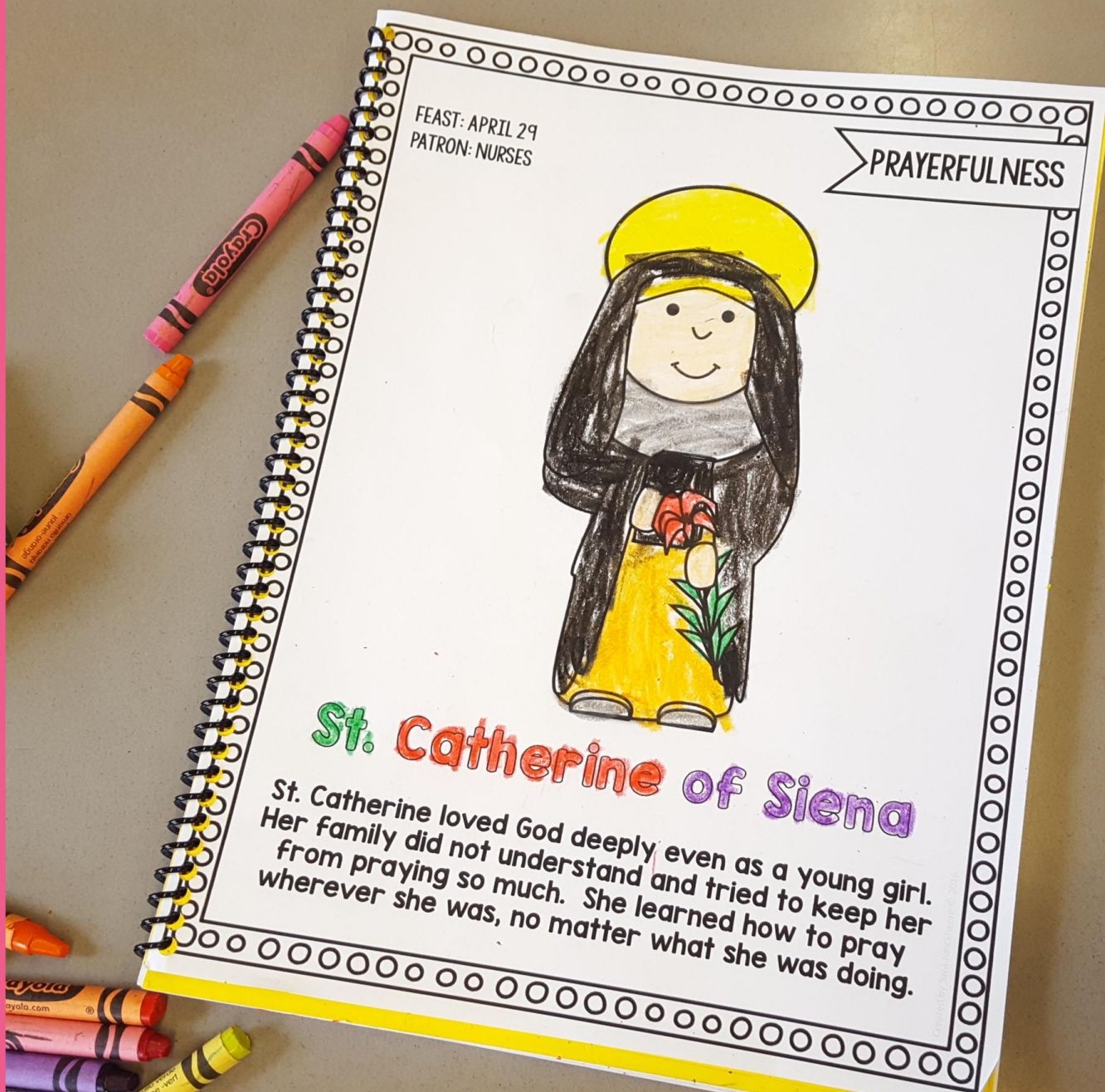

St. Dominic founded a reformed order of preachers. He spoke out against heresy and offered prayers and counsel to the sick. He was given the Rosary.

St. John Neumann
St. John Neumann studied to become a priest. He was the first bishop in Bohemia who wouldn't give up his faith. He started 100 Catholic churches and was hard to bring good teaching.

St. Lucy
St. Lucy told her mother the story of the parable of the talents. She was healed by touching the robe of Jesus. To attempt the same healing on Lucy's mother, she touched the tomb of St. Agatha. Her mother was instantly healed and allowed Lucy to give money to the poor and devote her life to God.

St. Veronica wiped the face of Jesus with her veil. He carried his cross on Good Friday. She is shown in the Sixth Station of the Cross. She is said to have wiped the Lord's pain and attempted to help by wiping his blood and sweat. An image of the Lord's face was left behind on the veil.
