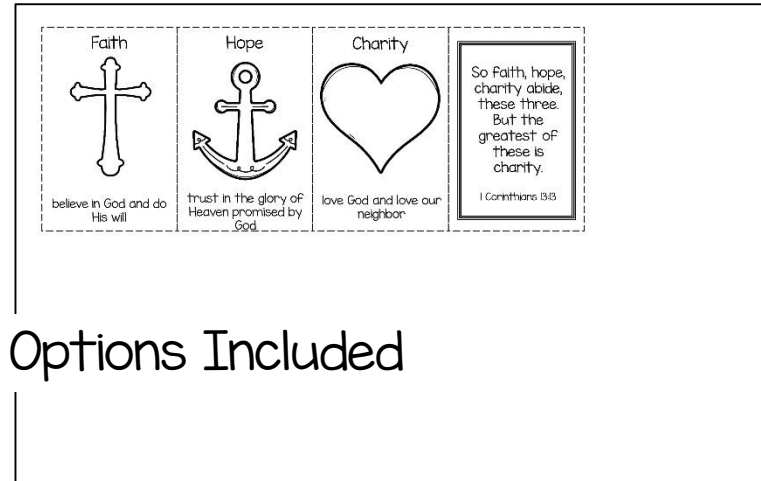
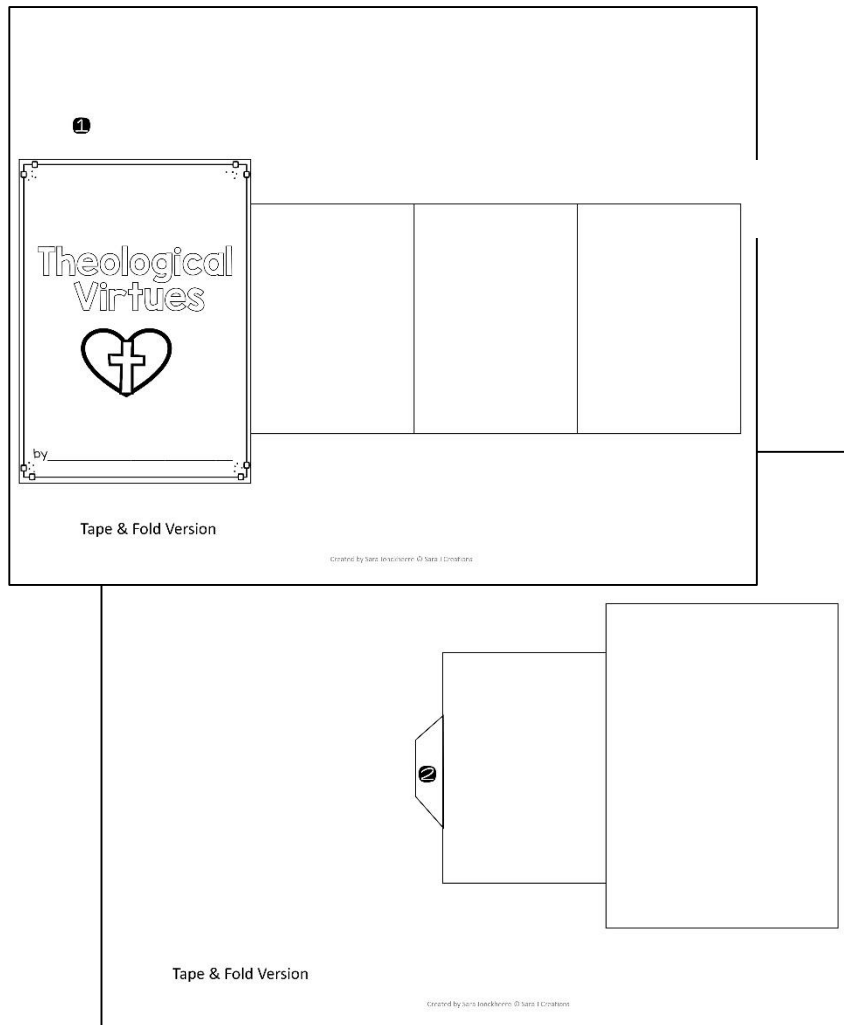

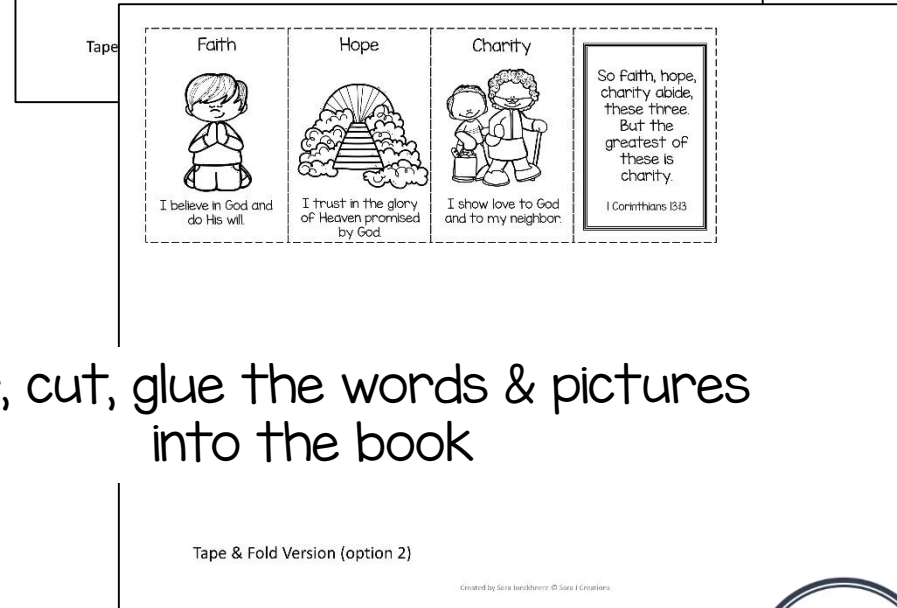
# TAPE & FOLD (ACCORDION) VERSION

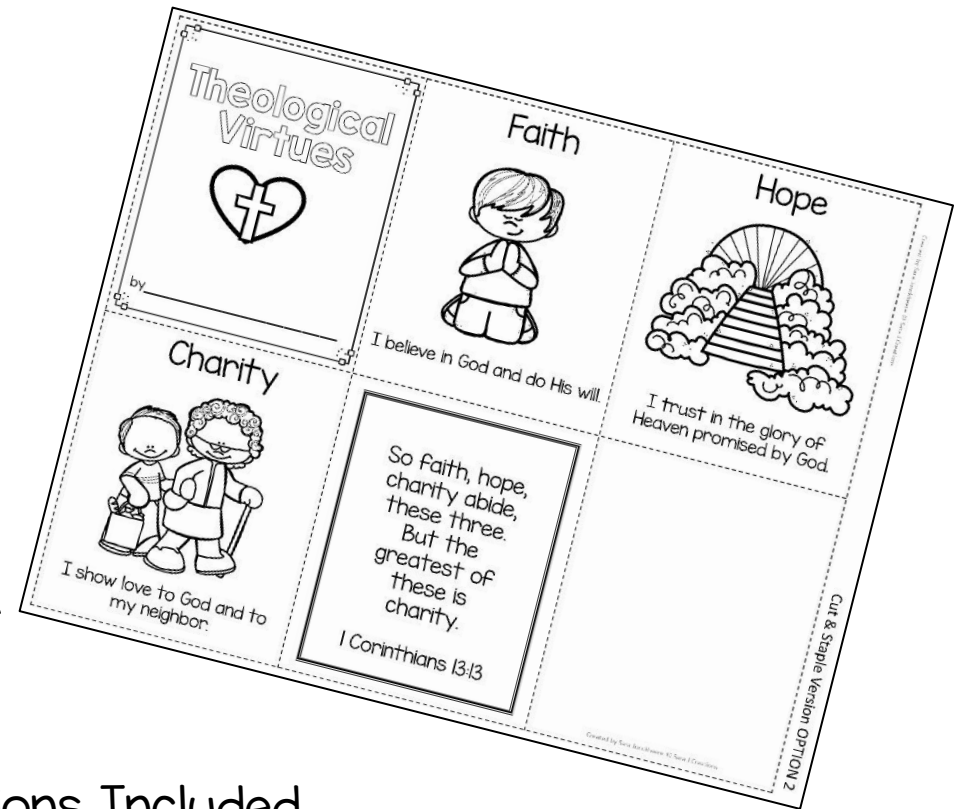
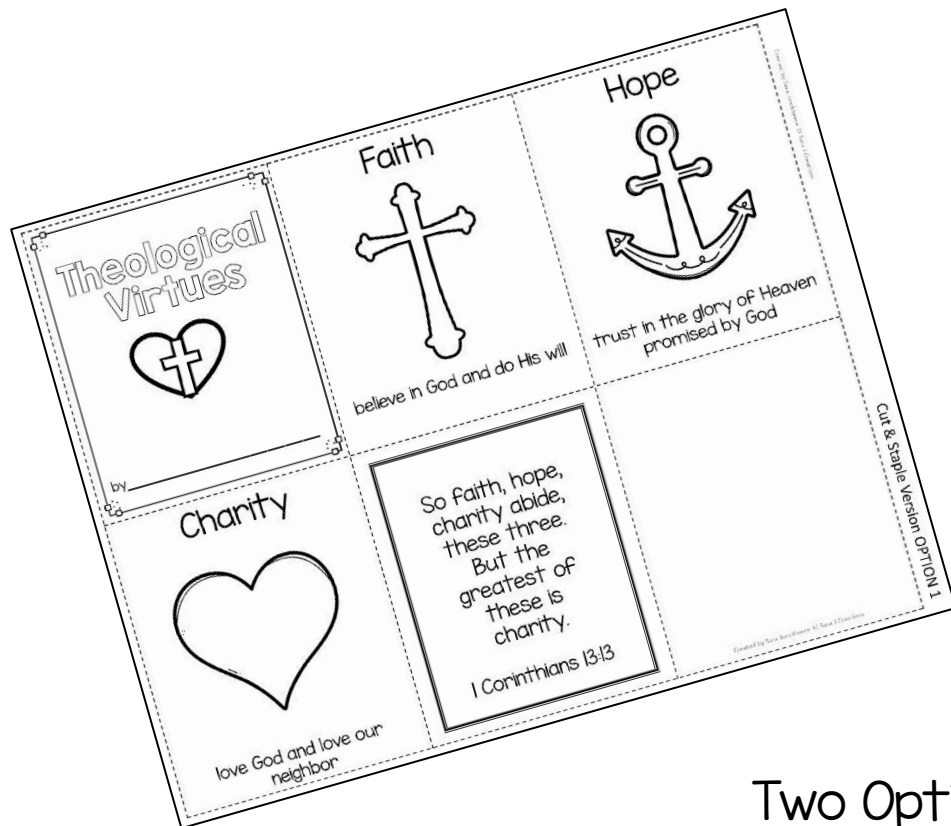

**Additional Information**

This information can be used to help explain the theological virtues or give more information for older students to add to their mini books.

Faith	We believe in God and believe all that he has said and revealed to us, we seek to know and do God's will, disciple of Christ must not only keep the faith and live on it, but also profess it, bear witness to it and spread it
Hope	We desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises and relying on the Holy Spirit instead of our own strength, hope is expressed and nourished in prayer, we hope in the glory of heaven promised by God to those who love him and do his will
Charity	Love God above all things and love our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God, by loving one another we imitate the love of Jesus, keeps the commandments of God, love even our enemies
