UPHOLSTERY FABRIC CHART

The following upholstery yardage chart is provided to give you an estimate of how many yards you need to reupholster your furniture piece. If you are working with an upholsterer we suggest you contact him/her for their recommended amount.

The following chart is based on a 54 inch wide solid fabric. Most of our fabrics have repeats that require matching. Allow 10-15% for matching pattern repeats. Allow extra for arm covers (1 yard for 2 arm covers) and self-lined skirts. It is always a good idea to get an extra yard or two "just in case". You wouldn't want to end up short and find out the fabric is no longer available, you might need it in the future for repairs. And you can always use the extra for pillows.

Approximate Yardage Shown Add 2 yards if button tuffing. Add 1 1/2 (1.5) yards if skirt for sofa. Add 3/4 (.75) yards if skirt for chair.



* Yardage amounts are based on Solid Fabrics, 54" wide. Extra amounts needed to match patterns.
