

## Decorative Macramé

### Roving Yarn



#### Materials:

3 skeins of **Crafted By Catherine Roving Yarn**

Wooden dowel

Twine

#### 1st Section:

Cut 4 pieces of soft silver roving yarn at 6 ft long.

For each 4 pieces of yarn, gently pull each apart to create 8 pieces.

Take your eight pieces and lay over the wooden dowel.

Find 2 strands in the back and pull forward to wrap around the top joining all the other strands together.

Once tight, tuck securely.

\*Repeat for section 3, 6, and 8\*

#### 2nd Section:

Cut 2 pieces of soft silver roving yarn and 2 pieces of ivory roving yarn at 6 ft long.

For each 4 pieces of yarn, gently pull each apart to create 8 pieces.

Blend your soft silver and ivory yarn gently when laying over wooden dowel.

Find 2 strands in the back and pull forward to wrap around the top joining all the other strands together.

Once tight, tuck securely.

Take your strands and divide into 3 sections and braid.

Leave some longer strands at the bottom of your braid.

Find 2 strands in the back and wrap around bottom of braid and tuck securely.

\*Repeat for section 7\*

#### 3rd Section:

Refer to 1st section.

#### 4th Section:

Cut 4 pieces of blue cove roving yarn at 6ft long

For each 4 pieces of yarn, gently pull each apart to create 8 pieces.

Take the eight pieces and lay over the wooden dowel.

Find 2 strands in the back and pull forward to wrap around the top joining all the other strands together.

Once tight tuck securely.

“Repeat for section 5”

#### 5th Section:

#### 6th Section:

Refer to section 1

#### 7th Section:

Refer to section 2

#### 8th Section:

Refer to section 1

After all sections are complete, trim the bottoms.

Leave sections 1 and 8 the shortest.

Sections 4 and 5 will be the same length and the longest of all the sections.

Sections 3 and 6 will be a little shorter than Sections 4 and 5.

Sections 2 and 7 will be shorter than 3 and 6 but not as short as sections 1 and 8.

Tie the twine around each end of the wooden dowel to make a hanger for the macramé.
