Can you describe:

- The sounds they hear?
- The smells of the bush?
- What they see?
- The feel of leaves and trees?

The dragon in the story is not really a dragon. What is it?

- Can you describe the lizard?
- Could you research and find what sort of lizard the dragon might be?
- What type of bird appears as the children's friend in the story?
 (You can look this up in a book about birds or on the internet)

Princess Molly and Prince Tom lie down and look at the clouds.

What shapes can you see in the clouds? Can you draw them?

Have you had a really great day exploring 'beyond your garden gate'?

• Describe your day. Who were you with? Where did you go? What did you do?

• What games can you come up with in the great outdoors?

At the start of the story Molly and Tom make crowns as part of their imagination game.
