

JEWELLERY CARE GUIDE

RHODIUM PLATING

White gold is finished with a rhodium plating to give it a pure white shine and improve durability. But it does wear off over time. That means you'll need to replace it. Depending on how often and how hard it's worn, the rhodium plating could last anywhere from one to three years.

DIAMONDS

A simple plan to keep your diamond jewellery looking beautiful is to soak it in a gentle degreasing solution, such as water with a few drops of mild dish soap, once or twice a week. After you remove the diamond from the cleaning solution, use a soft, clean toothbrush to remove any remaining dirt.

PEARLS

Pearls should be kept away from heat. When pearls are used in jewellery, they are usually always glued in. As the heat can destroy them. When cleaning pearls, it is recommended to use cold water, with a soft cleaning cloth to dry them.

EMERALDS

The best way to clean emerald is by rubbing the stone with a soapy cloth and then rinsing them lightly with water. Another smart habit is to avoid exposing emeralds to extreme temperatures. They have poor basal surfaces, so these extreme temperatures can create cracks in your stone.
