- Cream Print for background
- 2 Red Prints for flowers
- Tan Print for outer flower leaves & outer center circle
- Dark Tan Print for stems & inner center circle

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From cream print:

(1) 10 X 10 inch square

APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS: IMAGES ARE

REVERSED

- These instructions are for raw edge applique. You are free to use your favorite method for fabric applique.
- Trace the individual appliqué pieces on the paper side of the fusible web, leaving about ¼ inch

- around each shape. Remember to leave a little extension on the pieces where they fit under another piece. Cut the fusible web shapes apart and fuse to the appropriate colored fabric following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Cut the fabrics out on the drawn line on the fusible web.
- Refer to the photo and pattern sheet for placement and fuse all pieces to the 10" cream print square.
- Stitch applique pieces into place with a straight stitch, as close to the edge of the piece as possible staying on the applique piece.
- When applique is complete, trim block to 8 ½" square.
