WEEK 1 * FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING NOTES

FINISHED SIZE OF QUILT: 28 X 43 ½ INCHES

Below you will find fabric requirements & important cutting instructions to read and complete before you begin cutting individual blocks.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- ⅝ yard Red Mottled Fabric for inner borders & binding
- ⅝ yard Cream with Tan Print Fabric for applique blocks & pieced blocks
- ½ yard Cream with Red Print Fabric for outer borders
- 5 Red Print Fabric Fat Quarters for blocks & applique
- 4 Tan Print Fabric Fat Quarters for blocks & applique
- 4 Cream Print Fabric Fat Quarters blocks
- 7 X 9 inch piece of Brown Fabric for applique

OTHER SUPPLIES:

- Fusible Webbing
- Buttons available from Buttermilk Basin

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please Note: Specific cutting instructions will be given with the free pattern each week for that week's blocks; however, the following needs to be done before you begin cutting the individual blocks if you purchased one of our kits or purchased your own fabrics per the fabric requirements.

- 4 Red fat quarters: cut each into (2) fat eights, set one of each aside for applique, and use the 2nd one for cutting individual blocks

- 4 Tan fat quarters: cut each into (2) fat eights, set one of each aside for applique, and use the 2nd one for cutting individual blocks
- Before cutting fabric for pieced blocks, **from ⅝ yard cream with tan print fabric**, cut the applique block backgrounds as shown on the diagram below. The remaining fabric can be used for the pieced blocks.
- The cutting instructions for each block will not call out a specific print for the blocks. If it says "4 red prints", you will use all 4 in that block. If it says "2 cream prints", you can use any of the 4 prints, it is meant to be a bit scrappy.

Cut 8 ½" strip X width of fabric (wof), then cut (2) 8 ½" X 8 ½" squares for applique blocks

Cut 12 ½" strip X wof, then cut (1) 20 ½" long for applique block

Cut 4 ½" strip X wof, then cut (2) 4 ½" X 4 ½" applique blocks
