# Buttermilk Basin's Saturday sampler 

## week 3 * Make 4 Blocks Finished size of each block is $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

During our Saturday Sampler, beginning May 6, 2023, we will be releasing a NEW block or blocks, just for you to sew \& stitch into a fabulous quilt when all blocks are completed! Print the free pattern online or stop in the shop to pick up each week's pattern! Please read the introductory information on separate page prior to beginning. There is important fabric requirement \& cutting instructions.

## Fabric:

- 1 red print fabric
- 1 crem print fabric


## Cutting Instructions:

From red print:

- (2) $33 / 8 \times 33 / 8$ inch squares
- (4) $3 \times 3$ inch squares, then cut once on the diagonal


## From cream print:

- (2) $33 / 8 \times 33 / 8$ inch squares
- (4) $3 \times 3$ inch squares, then cut once on the diagonal

Seam allowances are always $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted \& fabrics are sewn right sides together.

## Sewing Instructions:

1. To make the square in a square blocks, sew a cream print 3 " triangle to 2 opposite sides of the red print $33 / 8$ " squares; press. Sew a

cream print $3^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to the 2 remaining sides of each red print square; press. Trim to $41 / 2 "$ if needed, making sure to leave $1 / 4$ " seam allowance outside center square corners to complete 2 units with red print centers.
2. Repeat step 1, with the cream print $3^{\prime \prime}$ triangles \& the red print $33 / 8 \prime$ squares to complete 2 units with cream print centers.
