SATURDAY SAMPLER

WEEK 5 * MAKE 4 BLOCKS

FINISHED SIZE OF EACH BLOCK IS 4 ½" X 4 ½"

During our Saturday Sampler, beginning May 6, 2023, we will be releasing a NEW block or blocks, just for you to sew & stitch into a fabulous quilt when all blocks are completed! Print the free pattern online or stop in the shop to pick up each week's pattern! Please read the introductory information on separate page prior to beginning. There is important fabric requirement & cutting instructions.

FABRIC:

- 2 red print fabrics
- 1 cream print fabric
- 1 tan print fabric

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From each red print:

- (2) 2 ⅞ X 2 ⅞ inch squares

From cream print:

- (4) 2 ⅞ X 2 ⅞ inch squares
- (16) 1 ½ X 1 ½ inch squares

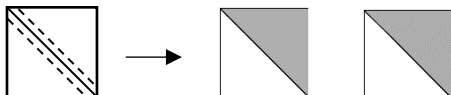
From tan print:

- (16) 1 ½ X 1 ½ inch squares

Seam allowances are always ¼" unless otherwise noted & fabrics are sewn right sides together (rst).

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Begin by making the half square triangle (hst) units. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the cream print 2 ⅞" squares. Layer a marked square, rst, with each red print square. Stitch ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line; press. Repeat to make 8 hst units. Each unit measures 2 ½" square.



2. To make the 4 patch units, sew the cream print 1 ½" squares and the tan print 1 ½" squares into pairs. Sew 2 pairs together to complete (8) 4 patch units.
3. Referring to the block diagram, arrange the hst units & the 4 patch units into 4 blocks, using the same red in a block. Sew the units into pairs, then sew the 2 pairs together to complete the 4 blocks. Each block measures 4 ½" square.
