# Buttermilk Basin's SATURDAY SAMPLER

# WEEK 4 \* MAKE 6 BLOCKS FINISHED SIZE OF EACH BLOCK IS 2 ½" X 4 ½"

During our Saturday Sampler, beginning May 6, 2023, we will be releasing a NEW block or blocks, just for you to sew & stitch into a fabulous quilt when all blocks are completed! Print the free pattern online or stop in the shop to pick up each week's pattern! Please read the introductory information on separate page prior to beginning. There is important fabric requirement & cutting instructions.

### FABRIC:

- 2 red print fabrics
- 1 cream print fabric
- 1 tan print fabric

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

#### From each red print:

- (1) 5 ¾ X 5 ¾ inch square
- From cream print:
  - (4) 3 ¼ X 3 ¼ inch squares

#### From tan print:

• (4) 3 ¼ X 3 ¼ inch squares

# Seam allowances are always ¼" unless otherwise noted & fabrics are sewn right sides together.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- To make the flying geese units, using the 4 at a time, no waste method, begin by drawing a diagonal line on the back of all cream print and tan print 3 ¼" squares.
- Referring to the diagram at right, place 2 marked cream print squares on opposite corners of a red print 5 ¾" square.



- Sew ¼" on both sides of the drawn line; cut on the drawn line; press toward cream print.
- 4. Referring to the diagram below, place 1 marked cream square in the corner of one of the units just completed.
- Sew ¼" on both sides of the drawn line; cut on the drawn line; press toward cream print to complete 2 flying geese units. Repeat with remaining marked



cream square on remaining unit, to complete 4 flying geese units. Trim to  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  X  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ , being sure to keep  $\frac{1}{4}$  seam allowance outside of point.

6. Repeat step 2 - 5 with the marked tan print squares & the other red print  $5 \frac{3}{4}$  square.
