## SATURDAY SAMPLER

WEEK 6 \* MAKE 2 BLOCKS  
FINISHED SIZE OF EACH BLOCK IS 4 ½" X 4 ½"

During our Saturday Sampler, beginning May 6, 2023, we will be releasing a NEW block or blocks, just for you to sew & stitch into a fabulous quilt when all blocks are completed! Print the free pattern online or stop in the shop to pick up each week's pattern! Please read the introductory information on separate page prior to beginning. There is important fabric requirement & cutting instructions.

### FABRIC:

- Cream Print for background
- Red Print for berries
- Tan Print for leaves
- Dark Tan Print for stems

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

#### From cream print:

- (2) 5 ½ X 5 ½ inch squares

### APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS: IMAGES ARE REVERSED

1. These instructions are for raw edge applique. You are free to use your favorite method for fabric applique. You will be making 2 identical blocks.
2. Trace the individual appliqué pieces on the paper side of the fusible web, leaving about ¼ inch

around each shape. Remember to leave a little extension on the pieces where they fit under another piece. Cut the fusible web shapes apart and fuse to the appropriate colored fabric following the manufacturer's instructions.

3. Cut the fabrics out on the drawn line on the fusible web.
4. Refer to the photo and pattern sheet for placement and fuse all pieces to the 5 ½" cream print squares.
5. Stitch applique pieces into place with a straight stitch, as close to the edge of the piece as possible, staying on the applique piece.
6. When applique is complete, trim each block to 4 ½" square.
