Buttermilk Basin's Saturday sampler

Week 9 * Make 1 Block size of block is 12 ½" X 20 ½"

During our Saturday Sampler, beginning May 6, 2023, we will be releasing a NEW block or blocks, just for you to sew & stitch into a fabulous quilt when all blocks are completed! Print the free pattern online or stop in the shop to pick up each week's pattern! Please read the introductory information on separate page prior to beginning. There is important fabric requirement & cutting instructions.

Fabric:

- Cream Print for background
- Red Print #1 for house, top of 2 flowers on left
- Red Print #2 for lower part of 2 flowers on left & outer star on lower right side (star is appliqued not pieced)
- Red Print #3 for flower on right
- Red Solid for small star (star is appliqued not pieced)
- Brown for door on house, body & tail of bird, inside of 3 leaves and ground on the left & right
- Dark Tan Print for roof, wing on bird and lower half of bottom left leaf
- Tan Print #1 for all flower stems
- Tan Print #2 for upper half of bottom left leaf, 4 leaves and center ground
- Cream Print #2 for center of star on lower right side and windows

Cutting Instructions:

From cream print:

• (1) 12 ½ X 20 ½ inch strip

Applique Instructions: Images are reversed

- 1. These instructions are for raw edge applique. You are free to use your favorite method for fabric applique.
- 2. Trace the individual appliqué pieces on the paper side of the fusible web, leaving about ¼ inch around each shape. Remember to leave a little extension on the pieces where they fit under another piece. Cut the fusible web shapes apart and fuse to the appropriate colored fabric following the manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. Cut the fabrics out on the drawn line on the fusible web
- 4. Refer to the photo and pattern sheet for placement and fuse all pieces to the 12 ½" X 20 ½" cream print strip. The ground applique pieces will be sewn into the seam when this piece is sewn into the quilt. Be sure to place the ground pieces even with the bottom of the cream print background.
- 5. Stitch applique pieces into place with a straight stitch, as close to the edge of the piece as possible, staying on the applique piece.
