WEEK 10 – QUILT FINISHING
SIZE OF QUILT IS 28 X 44 INCHES

Thank you for joining us during our Saturday Sampler free sew along! It has been great to see progress along the way by so many of you on Fans of Buttermilk Basin on Facebook – thank you for sharing!

Print the free pattern online! Please read the introductory information on separate page prior to beginning. There is important fabric requirement & cutting instructions.

FABRIC:

- Red Solid fabric for inner borders & binding
- Cream Print fabric for outer borders

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From red solid:

- (4) 2 ½ inches X width of fabric strips
- (2) 1 ½ X 36 ½ inch strips
- (2) 1 ½ X 22 ½ inch strips

From cream print:

- (2) 3 ½ X 38 ½ inch strips
- (2) 3 ½ X 28 ½ inch strips

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

1. Refer to the quilt diagram on the next page to lay out the quilt center, using all of the completed pieced blocks and applique blocks from weeks 1 - 9.
2. Sew the quilt center blocks together.
3. Sew a red solid 1 ½" X 36 ½" strip to the left & right sides of the quilt center.
4. Sew a red solid 1 ½" X 22 ½" strip to the top & bottom of the quilt center.

5. Sew a cream print 3 ½" X 38 ½" strip to the left & right sides of the quilt center.
6. Sew a cream print 3 ½" X 28 ½" strips to the top & bottom of the quilt center.

QUILT FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing; baste.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind quilt. Enjoy!
