Instructions:

Use the fusible technique to appliqué the oval. Cut out each wool piece & position in place. Use coordinating floss to blanket stitch around each piece securing them in place.

Finishing instructions.

Use black floss to chain stitch pins. Use red floss to stem stitch dangling thread.

Use rose floss to chain stitch lines on thread. Sew a ½ inch black button above thread, a ½ red button to the left and one to the right of scissor handles. Sew a ¼ inch red button below red button on left. Sew a small red button on end of each pin and one in joint of scissor. Use gray floss to stitch defining line between handles on scissor. Use charcoal floss to chain stitch line between blades.
