IMPORTANT INFORMATION & ROAD CLOSURES FOR TELOPEA RESIDENTS

The Canberra Times Marathon Festival will take place on Sunday 7th of April 2024. This year all five distances Marathon, Half Marathon, 10km, 5.4km and 2km Kids events are being held on Sunday 7 April. Sole Motive will be aiming to reduce the overall impact to business operations and residents along the course as much as possible. Information relating to event operations and road closures can be found below:

SUNDAY, APRIL 16 – TIME OF EVENTS:



All events will start and finish within the Parliamentary Triangle.

- The course brings participants through Telopea Park & New South Wales Crescent between the hours of 6:30am and 2:00pm.
- Delays are to be expected on the day of event.
- · Telopea Park East will remain open at all times.
- Telopea Park West will be closed between Manuka Circle and Wentworth Avenue between 4:00am and 2:00pm
- · Bowen Drive will be closed between Bowen Place and Wentworth Avenue between 4:00am and 2:00pm
- New South Wales Crescent will be closed between 4:00am and 2:00pm
- · Access to Kingston foreshore, Old Bus Depot and Glassworks will remain open at all times.
- For residents living on Telopea Park West, New South Wales Crescent and Bowen Drive, roads will be closed from 4:00am. It is highly recommended where possible vehicles are parked in alternate streets if travel is required between 6:30am and 2:00pm.
- There will be soft closures in place and resident access is still permitted for Macquarie, Young, Gipps and Darling street.
