

Leather Maintenance Products and Their Functions

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Cleaner, Conditioner & Protector for Finished Leathers

This product is suitable for general maintenance and cleaning of finished leathers. Its unique balance of ingredients work together to remove oils and dirt that have accumulated during normal use. The select blend of natural moisturizers maintains the suppleness of the leather and provides a natural barrier to protect the surface without compromising the pH of the hide.

Instructions for Use

For soiled areas or general maintenance, use a lightly damp sponge or cloth to first remove loose soil from the surface. Apply the Cleaner, Conditioner & Protector to a dry cloth and clean using a circular motion beginning at the periphery and working toward the center. It is recommended to clean the entire panel (i.e. arm). Application may be repeated as necessary. Sheen may be enhanced by buffing with a dry cloth.

Cleaner, Conditioner & Protector for Aniline Leathers

Aniline leathers do not receive any protective finishes. Care has to be taken to ensure that soil and stains are removed quickly in order to prevent fiber discoloration. Most anilines receive a soil-resistant treatment during production at the tannery to help protect against staining. Improper cleaning may remove some of the soil-resistant properties, but this Spinneybeck product imparts additional protection while cleaning.

Instructions for Use

Aniline leather should be tested in an inconspicuous area first. The area should discolor but should dry without staining; if this is the case you may proceed. Remove all soil and dirt with a lightly damp sponge from area to be cleaned. Apply Cleaner, Conditioner & Protector to a dry cloth and clean soiled area using a circular motion. If the color is somewhat darker after cleaning and drying, it will normally return to its original color within a few days. The process can be quickened by stretching the affected area.

Ink Remover for All Leathers

This product is designed to pull ink or marker stains from leather.

Instructions for Use

If the stain is fresh, it will usually come off with one simple application. Apply Ink Remover with a cotton-tipped swab or a cloth, let sit for a minute, then gently rub.

If the stain is not fresh, then mix the Ink Remover with corn starch to form a paste. Place the paste on the affected area and allow to dry. Once dry, remove by vacuum cleaning or by gently brushing area.

After using Ink Remover, clean the area with the appropriate Cleaner, Conditioner & Protector to restore moisture removed during the process.
