- BCI Farmers minimise the harmful impact of crop protection practices
- •BCI Farmers promote water stewardship
- •BCI Farmers care for the health of the soil
- •BCI Farmers enhance biodiversity and use land responsibly
- •BCI Farmers care for and preserve fibre quality
- •BCI Farmers promote decent work
- •BCI Farmers operate an effective management system
