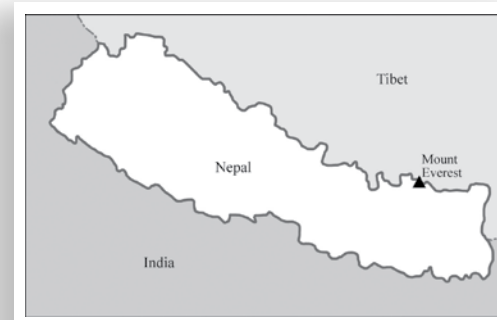




Mount Everest is 29,028 feet
