- Please protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste.


GETTING STARTED

Take the Connectrix - JUMOR out of the storage slot.

Battery Installation

The Connectrix - JUNIOR operates on 3 AA (LR06) batteries.

- 1. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit.
- 2. Open the battery cover with a screwdriver.
- 3. Insert 3 AA (LR06) batteries as illustrated.
- 4. Close the battery cover and screw it back.




SLEEP MODE

- 1. If the **Connectrix JUNIOR** is not active for more than 2 minutes, it will automatically go into sleep mode to save power.
- To wake up the system, either reset by the mode switch or press the enter button.

HOW TO PLAY


1. Switch ON & Choose the play mode

Choose the play mode, I for CO-OP Mode or II for VS Mode.



2. Insert the lesson card & Input the card code

Insert the lesson card into the slot and input the card code with controller then press the enter button to begin the lesson.



3. Follow the question & Find the matching answer

- Once you entered the card code, the system starts to ask questions randomly by the voice and the LCD displaying as well.
- Just follow the question, finding the matching answer of the card, and input the answer code then press the enter button with your controller.
- The system will tell you the answer is correct or not by the sounds and flashing the green light for correct; the red light for incorrect.

Determine your answer number or repeat the question.




LCD DISPLAYING

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Keep product away from foods and beverages.
- Clean with a slightly damp cloth (cold water) and mild soap.
- Never submerge the product in water.
- Remove batteries during prolonged storage.
- Avoid exposing product to extreme temperatures.

BATTERY SAFETY

- Batteries are small parts and choking hazards to children, must be replaced by an adult.
- Follow the polarity (+/-) diagram in the battery compartment.
- Promptly remove dead batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of used batteries properly.
- Remove batteries from prolonged storage.
- Only batteries of the same type as recommended are to be used.
- DO NOT incinerate used batteries.
- DO NOT dispose of batteries in fire, as batteries may explode or leak.
- DO NOT mix old and new batteries.
- DO NOT mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH) batteries.
- DO NOT recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- DO NOT short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

TROUBLESHOOTING
