

HOW TO HANG

THE AZIBO WOVEN WALL HANGING

First things first, get all your materials together. You should have received three screws or nails, depending upon the size you chose. Next, decide whether you'd like to display your piece arch side up or flat side up.


ARCH SIDE UP

STEP ONE: MEASURE & MARK THE TOP

Grab your measuring tape. Measure the width of the bottom of your wall hanging to find the halfway point. Then, choose the perfect spot to hang – hold your wall hanging against the wall, mark the top of your wall hanging with painter's tape and mark just below the top with a pencil marking.

STEP TWO: YOU KNOW THE DRILL

Drill the first screw into the pencil marking, leaving about 1.5 cm of the screw exposed from the wall. Hang your wall hanging on the screw to make sure it's level.



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
ARCH SIDE UP (CONTINUED)

STEP THREE: 'X' MARKS THE SPOTS

Mark two spots ten inches away from the center for the large wall hanging and eight inches away for the medium wall hanging, just below the top edge.

STEP FOUR: THE FINAL STEP


Remove the wall hanging, then drill two screws into these spots on the wall, leaving about 1.5 cm of the screw exposed from the wall. Then, hang up the wall hanging, and step back to admire your work.



FLAT SIDE UP

STEP ONE: MEASURE & MARK THE TOP

Have a friend hold the wall hanging up in your desired spot. Make sure it's level. Then, mark the wall, inside the corners, just below the top.



STEP TWO: 'X' MARKS THE SPOTS

Drill the screws into the wall, leaving 1.5 cm exposed from the wall.

STEP THREE: LET'S HANG

Then, hang up the wall hanging, and step back to admire your work.
