

HANDLEBAR INSTRUCTIONS

## THANK YOU FOR SELECTING A NEW NUKEPROOF HANDLEBAR.

With proper care and installation, it will give you trouble-free, enjoyable use. In order to maximise the safe enjoyment of this product, you should read and carefully follow the following installation instructions and warnings. Failure to do so could result in unexpected wear and or failure, possibly resulting injury. We recommend having your parts fitted by a qualified bicycle mechanic. Nukeproof assumes no responsibility for malfunction or injury due to faulty installation.

## HANDLEBAR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: Prior to installation please ensure the stem you plan to use has the correct clamping diameter. We recommend that no stem with a handlebar clamping force greater than 8Nm be used with this handlebar. If in any doubt, please consult your dealer.

- 1. Inspect your stem for any burrs or rough spots that could damage the handlebar. If any such conditions are found, take the stem to your dealer. If not, continue to step 2;
- 2. Clean the clamping area on your handlebars and stem to maximise the clamping ability of the components;
- 3. Make sure that the bolt threads on the stem clamps are well lubricated with a high quality grease;
- 4. Centre the clamp over the centre section of the handlebar and rotate the bars as desired in the clamp;
- Tighten the stem clamps to the correct torque using the correct size tool. Please confirm the correct tightening torque with the stem's manufacturer. Be careful not to over-torque the bolts as this may result in damage to both the stem and the bar;
- 6. Check that the installed handlebar does not slip or rotate when pressure is applied to it;
- 7. Install the remaining components (brake levers, cycle computers, etc.) in accordance with their respective manufacturer's instructions.

## "LIMITED WARRANTY"

Nukeproof warrants this product to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a two-year period from the date of original retail purchase. This warranty is extended only to the original owner of the product. Proof of purchase is required for any warranty service, so be sure to keep your receipt.
