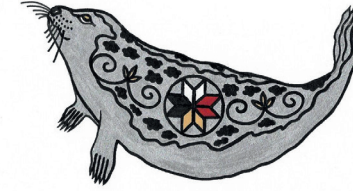


Guardians of the Environment

What is Waspu Oil

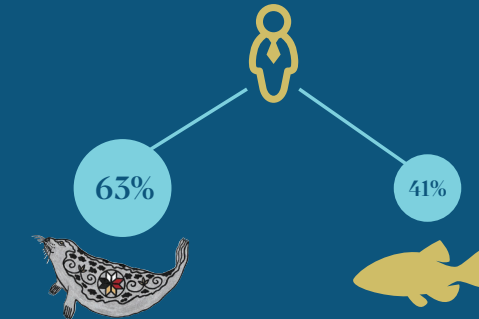

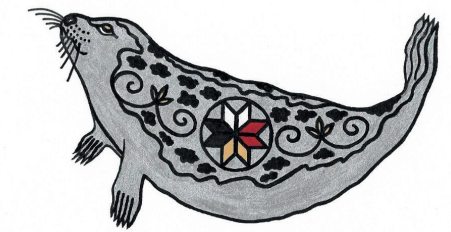
Process & Facilities

Rendered from Harp seals in Newfoundland and Labrador, Canada, the oil is further refined in a process known as 'Bleaching and Deodorization'. This additional refining reduces the concentration of trace metals, oxidation values, PCB's, dioxins, and furans, maximizing health benefits for consumers.

Once the oil is encapsulated it is then bottled and prepared for market at our facility in Newfoundland. The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) and/or Health Canada certify all facilities used in the production chain. The oil contained in the capsules meet or exceed all Canadian and World Health Organization (WHO) standards. Our registered Natural Product number is 80097519.

WASPU is the Mi'kmaq Word for Seal.

In Indigenous culture, the seal represents imagination, creativity, trust, and integrity. For hundreds of years Indigenous cultures of Newfoundland and Labrador have relied upon seals. A large percentage of the seal was eaten, and the rest of the animal was used for clothing, tools, and crafts. Within the spirit of this Seal, as depicted in our logo, we see the ancient Mi'kmaq Eight-Pointed Star with the four direction colours symbolizing diversity and inclusiveness of all nations on Earth. Mi'kmaq double curve designs are painted on each side of the Mi'kmaq Star representing balance of nature, environmental conservation, and guardianship.



Why Seal Oil?



Contains DPA
Seal oil is one of the only sources (like mother's milk) with naturally occurring high levels of DPA.



Preserved Purity
Most Omega-3s on the market are 100% chemically altered. Seal oil is 100% natural and pure.



100% Canadian
Seal Oil is harvested in Canada's pristine waters, unlike most Omega-3 fish oil.



Optimal Absorption
Seal oil is more easily absorbed by humans compared to fish oil. This means no "fishy burps."
