Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of most finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

If you do not have the item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use the items that you have in your stash.




# Set A: 4-1/2 x 6-1/4" Light Maize Cards with Dark Maize Panels

#### Card #1



- Light Maize Card with Dark Maize Panel
- ☐ Bisque Die Cut: Wide Square Frame
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: Narrow Square Frame
- □ UM Font
- □ WM "Happy Birthday" Stamp
- 1. Stamp the word "Hi" within the nested die cut frames with Earth ink. (All of the die cuts included in this set can be layered or nested. Punch them all out and play!)

#### Card #2



- ☐ Light Maize Card with Dark Maize Panel
- ☐ UM Font
- ☐ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- ☐ WM "Happy Birthday" Stamp
- 1. Stamp the word "hello" onto the panel with Earth ink and UM Font.
- 2. Tilt the Dark Maize panel when attaching to the card.



- Light Maize Card with Dark Maize Panel
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Call Me!"
- ☐ WM Telephone Stamp
- □ Blue Satin Ribbon
- □ Foam Adhesive
- □ Black Brush Tip Marker
- 1. Stamp the WM telephone image directly onto the Light Maize card with Earth ink.
- 2. Stamp the WM telephone twice onto the Dark Maize panel with Earth ink. Cut one stamped phone image from the panel with a scissors. Cut selected elements from the second stamped image. Edge the image pieces with a black marker to add definition.
- 3. Assemble and attach the images to the card with foam adhesive.





- Light Maize Card with Dark Maize Panel
- Bisque Die Cuts: "Hello" (Plain Side) and "Big Hugs"
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Hey There"
- 1. Easy, quick and cute! Arrange the die cuts on the card with layers of foam tape.

#### Card #5



- Light Maize Card with Dark Maize Panel
- □ Bisque Die Cut: "Get Well Soon" (Hidden)
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Happy Birthday"
- ☐ (6) Miniature Silver Brads
- □ WM "Happy Birthday" Stamp
- 1. Stamp the right edge of the panel with "Happy Birthday" and Topaz ink.
- 2. Distress the perimeter of the "Happy Birthday" die cut and nest onto the Bisque die cut, covering the "Get Well Soon" expression.
- 3. Attach the nested die cuts to the panel with silver brads.

# Set B: 3-1/4 x 6-1/4" Navy Tri-Fold Cards with Light Maize and Bisque Panels Card #1



- Navy Card with Light Maize and Bisque Panels
- □ (2) Silver Mini Brads
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Congratulations"
- □ Navy Satin Ribbon
- ☐ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- 1. Trim ½" from the long edge of the Bisque panel. Attach to the top of the horizontal navy card. Fold up a portion of the front panel of the Navy card to create a flap. Secure the flap with two mini brads.
- 2. Top the die cut with ribbon and insert into the flap.
- 3. Attach the Light Maize panel to the second fold of the card, and stamp the UM "Talk" image across the bottom edge of the revealed panel.





- Navy Card with Light Maize and Bisque Panels
  Dark Maize Die Cut: "Smile"
  Navy Mini Brad
- 1. Oh, so simple! Just attach the die cut to the Bisque panel and insert the brad into the dot of the "i" in "smile."

# Card #3



- Navy Card with Light Maize and Bisque Panels
- ☐ Bisque Die Cut: "Happy Anniversary!"
- Dark Maize Die Cuts: "Happy Anniversary!" and "Wow!"
- □ Stencil
- □ (2) Navy Mini Brads
- 1. Stencil the word "Hello" and the telephone image onto a horizontal Bisque panel with Topaz ink.
- 2. Nest and attach the pair of die cuts with navy brads.




- Navy Card with Light Maize Panel
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Hope You're Feeling Better" (Hidden)
- □ Bisque Die Cuts: "Happy Birthday," "As You Get Older...," and "Hey There!"
- □ (2) Silver Mini Brads
- 1. Tear away two thirds of the front Navy card panel and one third of the second Navy panel.
- 2. Nest the die cuts and attach to the Light Maize panel with silver brads. Attach the panel to the inside back of the card.
- 3. Attach the remaining Bisque die cuts to the first and second panels of the tri-fold card, as shown.






- Navy Card with Light Maize and Bisque Panels
- Stencil
- □ WM "Happy Birthday" Stamp
  - UM Font
  - Watercolors and Water Spray Bottle
- Lightly mist the stencil with water and color the stencil surface around the telephone image with blue watercolor. (I used a watercolor crayon.) Press the Light Maize panel onto the colored stencil and burnish to make good contact. Allow the panel to dry completely or dry with a heat tool.
- 2. Stamp the UM number row onto the panel as shown with Topaz ink.
- 3. Stamp "Happy Birthday" onto the lower right corner of the card with Earth ink.

**Set C: 5x7" Dark Maize Cards with Bisque Panels** Card #1




- Dark Maize Card with Bisque Panel
- □ Dark Blue Satin Ribbon
- ☐ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Tear away a 2" strip from the front panel of the Dark Maize Card. Attach the Bisque panel inside the card and stamp the greeting in the lower right corner with Sapphire ink. (Save the torn strip for the next card.)
- 2. Tie the ribbon into a small bow and layer onto the torn edge of the card with your favorite adhesive.



- Dark Maize Card with Bisque Panel
- □ Dark Maize Strip (From Set C, Card #1)
- ☐ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- ☐ Maize Grosgrain Ribbon
- ☐ Bisque Die Cut: "Gosh, I Sure Miss You"
- 1. Stamp the UM "phone book listing" image onto the Dark Maize Strip with Topaz ink. Attach to the Bisque panel and trim to fit. Wrap a length of ribbon around the panel.
- 2. Stamp the UM phone image onto the lower right corner of the panel with Earth ink. Attach the Bisque die cut with foam tape.





- Dark Maize Card with Bisque Panel
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "May All Your Wishes..."
- □ Bisque Die Cut: Narrow Square Frame
- ☐ Maize Grosgrain Ribbon
- 1. Hold the pair of die cuts together as shown. Weave the ribbon over and under the die cut frames.
- 2. Secure the ribbon to the back of the die cuts with adhesive and attach to the Bisque panel.

### Card #4



- Dark Maize Card with Bisque Panel
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Best Wishes"
- □ Bisque Die Cut: "You're the Best"
- □ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ Dark Blue Satin Ribbon
- 1. Stamp the UM "Smile" quote in a diagonal pattern on the Bisque panel with Topaz ink.
- Nest the die cuts and thread with satin ribbon. Attach the die cuts to the panel with foam tape; wrap ribbon ends around the back of the panel.



- □ Dark Maize Card with Bisque Panel
- □ Dark Maize Die Cut: "Wishing You Another Year..."
- ☐ Bisque Die Cut: "Hey! How Are You?"
- □ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ Watercolors
- Stamp the UM phone book listing image repeatedly onto the Bisque panel with Topaz ink. Stamp the UM phone image with Earth ink and fill in with watercolor.
- 2. Nest the Bisque die cut onto the Dark Maize Die Cut and attach to the card.
