

# Assembly Line Cardmaking March 2020 Club Scrap® Card Kit Western

### Materials and Tools:

- Western CS® Card Kit
- □ 12" Paper Trimmer
- Accordion Pocket File
- □ ScorPal
- □ Adhesive
- □ Tape
- □ 3x14" CS® Grid Ruler
- □ Scissors
- □ CS® Bookbinding Glue

- Needle-tipped Glue Applicator
- Corner Chomper or Corner Rounding Punch
- □ Stapler and Staples
- Texture Embossing Folder (Optional)
- □ Embossing Machine (Optional)
- Dazzles Jewels Stickers (Optional)
- □ (2) Mini Brads for the Folio Cover (Optional)
- Depart Piercing Tool and Cork Board

Measurement Conversions:  $.25 = \frac{1}{4''}$ .5 =  $\frac{1}{2''}$ .75 =  $\frac{3}{4''}$ 

#### Preparation:

Trim the printed cutaparts and papers into sections as indicated by the artwork or detailed instructions. While trimming the cutaparts and papers, distribute the pieces to a pile or file designated for each card set as referenced in the diagram.


If there is an arrow on the paper trimming diagram, make sure the paper grain dips easily in the same direction as the arrow when placing the paper into the trimmer.




12x12 Cutapart









 Trim one Gold and one Burgundy at 8.5". Cut the 8.5x12 at 10.5". Trim the 1.5x8.5 horizontally at 5.5". Cut the 3.5x12 at 10". Score and fold the 3.5x10 at 5". Score the 8.5x10.5 vertically at 2 and 6.5". Score horizontally at 6 and 6.5". Score at 45° angles, as shown in the diagram.



3. Cut one Burgundy and one Print at 8.5". Trim the 8.5x12 at 11". Cut the 8.5x11 vertically at 4.25". Trim the 1x8.5 and 6.25". Cut the 3.5x12 at 10". Score and fold each 4.25x11 horizontally at 5.5". Score and fold the 3.5x10 horizontally at 5".




 Trim one Blue at 8.25 and 4.5". Cut the 4.5x12 at 6". Trim each 3.75x12 at 10 and 5". Score each 4.5x6 at 4.5 and 5".




4. Trim one lvory and one Gold at 9". Cut the 9x12 at 11.75, 10.5 and 9.25". Rotate and cut the 9x9.25 vertically at 4.5". Trim each 1.25x9 horizontally at 8.5 and 4.25". Cut the 3x12 at 9 and 4.5". Score each 4.5x9.25 horizontally at 1.5 and 7.75; flip and score at 3 and 6.25".





5. Trim one lvory and one Brown at 8.5". Cut the 8.5x12 at 11 and 5.5". Cut the 1x8.5 at 6.25". Trim the 3.5x12 at 9.5 and 4.75". Score and fold each 5.5x8.5 horizontally at 4.25".




6. Trim the Print at 11.75, 8.5 and 4.25<sup>27</sup>. Cut one 4.25x12 at 11.5, 8.5 and 4.25". Trim one 4.25x12 and 9, 6 and 3". Cut the 3.25x12 at 9.5 and 4.75".

## Set A: 4¼x5½" Cards




Inside: "Let's get together soon."

Assembly steps for all cards: Emboss plain panels and paper strips with a paisley texture folder, and rub raised surfaces with Earth ink. Round corners of panels with a punch, if desired. Interchange colors of the panels and nest onto the folded card base. Add the corresponding sentiment to the inside of the card.

#### **Embellishment tips:**

Mat the leather tag with a scrap of 5%x2" scrap with rounded corners.

Add a Dazzles Jewel Sticker to the center of a flower charm and adhere with Bookbinding Glue.

Wrap a card panel twice with jute fiber and tie a knot. Thread a horseshoe charm onto one thread tail and tie a bow.















Set B: 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>x5" Cards



Inside: "It's your day. Happy birthday."



#### Inside: "Have a great day!"



Assembly steps for cards at left: Attach the leather tag onto a 1x2.25" scrap with rounded corners. Round the corners of the cutapart and panel, and nest onto a folded card base.



Assembly steps for cards at right: Make slits around the printed belt buckle and on each side of the loop with a sharp craft knife. Thread brown ribbon through the slits and tape the ends to the back of the cutapart. Round the corners of the panels and cutapart, and nest onto the folded card base.

#### Set C: 41/2x61/4" Bridge Cards





**Assembly steps for all cards:** Fold along the score lines to create two outer mountain folds and two inner valley folds. Nest the prepared panels onto the outer flaps and center card base. Nest the sentiment onto the 1x6.25" panel. Apply adhesive to the left and right side of the panel only and attach to the card base while flat. Fussy-cut objects from the cutapart sheet and add to the cards, as shown.

**Folio Assembly:** Fold along all score lines of the 8.5x11" folio papers, including the 45° angles. Use the angled folds to create four pleats that form a rectangular box. Miter the outside corners of the folio flap and apply glue to the tab. Attach the flap to the top edge of the *longest wall* of the folio. Round the corners of the flaps with a punch. Glue down the side walls of the folio, keeping the center areas free of glue. Nest the decorative paper panel onto the flap after rounding the corresponding corners. If desired, pierce a hole through the flower charm with a piercing tool and attach to the front center of the flap with a mini brad. Add a pair of hook/loop dots to the inside of the flap to secure. Slide a set of four cards and four envelopes into the pocket of each folio.
