Materials and Tools:

- Magnolia CS® Card Kit
- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Accordion Pocket File
- ScorPal
- Adhesive
- Tape
- Foam Adhesive Tape






Trim the papers and cutaparts into sections as indicated by the detailed instructions. While trimming, distribute the pieces to a pile or file designated for each card set as referenced in the diagram. Prior to trimming the cutaparts, remove approximately 1/8" from the perimeter of each sheet, using the intersecting guidelines on each corner as a cutting guide.

If there is an arrow on the paper trimming diagram, make sure the paper grain dips easily in the same direction as the arrow when placing the paper into the trimmer.









2. Cut one White Linen, Green, Wine Linen and Pink at 10.25 and 7". Trim the 7x12 at 10.75 and 8.5". Cut the 2.25x7 at 6.75, 4.5 and 2.25". Trim the 3.25x12 at 8.25". Cut the 1.75x12 at 7.5 and 4.25". Score each 7x8.5 vertically at 3.5".







3. Trim one White Linen, Green, Wine Linen and Pink at 11.75 and 7". Cut the 7x12 at 10 and 5". Trim the 2x7 at 6, 4 and 2". Cut the 4.75x12 at 11.75, 11.5, 10, 8.5, 6.25 and 4". White paper smooth side up (if applicable), score one 5x7 of each color at .5 and 6.5". Flip the paper bottom to top and score at 2.25 and 4.75".



4. Cut one Print at 11.75 and 7.25". Trim the 7.25x12 at 10, 7.5, 5 and 2.5". Cut the 4.5x12 at 10, 8, 6 and 4".



5. Trim one Print at 8 and 4". Cut two 4x12 pieces at 10.5 and 5.25". Trim one 4x12 at 11, 8.25, 5.5 and 2.75".




6. Cut one Cutapart at 10.5, 9, 7.5 and 3.75". Trim each 3.75x12 strip at 10 and 5". Cut one 1.5x12 at 9, 6 and 3". Trim two 1.5x12 pieces at 10.5, 9, 7.5, 6, 4.5 and 3".





7. Trim one Cutapart at 11.5, 8 and 4". Cut two 4x12 pieces at 9.5, 8, 6.5 and 3.25". Trim the 3.5x12 at 9, 6 and 3".



8. Cut the 5.5x7.5 Crinkled Paper horizontally at 5.5 and 2.75". Trim each 2.75x5.5 at 2.75".

Set A: 41/4x51/2" Cards

Assembly steps: View the workshop video at 30:54 to learn how to fold the 2.75" Crinkled Paper square into a miniature envelope. Wrap the envelope with the waxed cord and tie a bow. Round the top corners of the cutapart sentiment, staple with folded ribbon, and nest onto the 1.75x3.25" panel. Slide the tag into the envelope. If desired, add texture to the 3.5x4.75" panel with an embossing folder. Nest the 4x5.25, 3.5x4.75 and 2.75x4" panels together and layer onto the card. Adhere the mini envelope. Finish with the inner greeting.

Set B: 31/2x81/2" Slimline Cards

Assembly steps: For the vertical cards, wrap two opposite corners of the 3.25x8.25" panel with ribbon and nest onto the folded card base. For the horizontal cards, stretch a piece of ribbon across the center of the 3.25x8.25" panel. Nest the 1.5" square cutaparts onto the 2" and 2.25" squares with foam adhesive. Evenly space and adhere the squares to the 2.5x7.25" printed panel and center onto the card. Add an embroidered leaf to the vertical card, and finish with the inner cutapart sentiment.

Set C: 5x7" Bay Window Cards

Assembly steps: Crease all score lines on the 5x7" panel; adhere one 1/2" tab to the edge of a non-scored 5x7" panel. Nest the five corresponding panels onto the scored sections on the front of the card. Nest a second 2x4.5" printed panel onto the center area. Add a ribbon accent to the 3x3.5" cutapart and nest onto the 3.25x3.75" panel. Center onto the die cut flower, and adhere to the center panel only. Open the card and add a 4x4.75" and 2.25x4.75 panel to the inside of the card. Nest the inner cutapart sentiment onto a 1.75x3.25" panel. Add foam adhesive to the vertical center of the nested sentiment and adhere to the 2.25x4.75" panel on the inside of the card. Adhere the 3.25x4" sentiment to the 4x4.75" panel on the inside of the card. Tuck the 1/2" tab on the right side of the card flap behind the inner sentiment to create a "bay window" effect when the card is on display. Remove the tab from behind the sentiment to flatten the card for mailing. Embellish two cards with an embroidered leaf.
