Materials and Tools:

- □ Reef CS® Card Kit
- □ 12" Paper Trimmer
- Accordion Pocket File
- □ ScorPal
- Adhesive
- □ Tape

- Foam Adhesive Tape
- □ 3x14" CS® Grid Ruler
- □ Scissors
- □ CS® Bookbinding Glue
- Needle-tipped Glue Applicator
- Staples and Stapler

Measurement Conversions: $.25 = \frac{1}{4}$ "






Preparation:

Trim the papers and cutaparts into sections as indicated by the detailed instructions. While trimming, distribute the pieces to a pile or file designated for each card set as referenced in the diagram.

If there is an arrow on the paper trimming diagram, make sure the paper grain dips easily in the same direction as the arrow when placing the paper into the trimmer.







1. Trim one Yellow, Gold, Seafoam and White at 11.25 and 7".

Rotate and cut the 7x12 at 10".

Trim the 4.25x12 at 11.5".

Cut the .75x12 at 6.25".

Score each 7x10 horizontally at 5".

If applicable, start with the smooth side up. Score each 4.25x12 horizontally at 2, 4, 7.5 and 9.5". Flip the paper bottom to top and score at 4.5 and 7".

2. Cut one Yellow, Gold, Seafoam and Green at 11.75, 10 and 6.25".

Rotate and trim the 6.25x12 at 9".

Trim the 3.75x12 at 6.5".

Cut the 1.75x12 at 10 and 6.75".

Score each 6.25x9 horizontally at 4.5".

Score each 3.75x6.5 horizontally at 3.25".


3. Trim one Green at 8 and 4".

Rotate and stack two 4x12 strips and cut at 10.5, 8.75, 7, 5.25, 3.5 and 1.75".

Trim one 4x12 at 10.75, 9.5, 8.25, 7, 5.25, 3.5 and 1.75".

Cut each 1.25x3.25 at 3.25".





4. Cut one Print at 10.25 and 6".

Rotate and trim the 6x12 at 11, 8.25, 5.5 and 2.75".

Cut the 4.25x12 at 6".

Trim the 1.75x12 at 7.5 and 3.75".

5. Place one Print into the trimmer with the top edge of the art on the left; trim at 11.75, 8 and 4.25".

Rotate and cut the 4.25x12 at 6".

Trim each 3.75x12 at 10.5, 9, 7.5, 6, 4.5, 3 and 1.5".

 Remove approximately ½" from the perimeter of the cutapart, using the intersecting marks on each corner as a cutting guide.


Cut at 8, 7 and 3.5".

Rotate and trim each 3.5x12 at 9, 6 and 3".

Cut the 1x12 at 9, 6 and 3".

Trim the 4x12 at 10.25, 8.5, 6.75, 5 and 3.25".

Remove the shells from the 4x3.25" piece with scissors.



7. Remove approximately 1/2" from the perimeter of the cutapart, using the intersecting marks on each corner as a cutting guide.

Trim at 10.25, 8.75 and 4.5".

Rotate and cut the 4.5x12 at 9, 6 and 3".

Trim the 4.25x12 at 9, 6 and 3".

Cut the 1.5x12 at 9, 6 and 3".

Trim the 1.75x12 at 8 and 4".




Floating by TO SAY HELLO...

Inside: "... and happy birthday!"

Set A: Clamshell 41/4x51/2" Cards

Assembly steps: (The first step is optional.) Use a ruler and craft knife to remove a ½x3½" strip from the top and bottom edges of the card base, from the 2nd score line to the 5th score line. Fold all score lines, keeping the bump of



the line on the inside of the fold to create four "valley folds" and two "mountain folds." Nest the 1.5x3.75" printed panels onto the 1.75x4" Green panels and add to the outer and inner card flaps. Nest the 1.75x4" Cutapart panels onto the scored area on the inside of the card. Fold the 3.75x6.5" scored piece in half. Add ribbon, if desired, to the outer sentiment and nest the outer/inner sentiment to the folded piece. Adhere to the center pop-up panel of the card.








Set B: 41/2x61/4" Stack, Cut and Shuffle Cards

Assembly steps: (The stack, cut, and shuffle portion of the card can be skipped; simply nest the 3.75x5.5" panel onto the 4.25x6" Print and folded card base.) Stack the four 3.75x5.5" card panels and trim at an angle. Carefully tracking the pieces, trim each cut section at a different angle to create a total of four pieces. Distribute one piece of each color onto four 4.25x6" printed panels and adhere, as shown. Center the panel onto the folded card base. Nest the 1x3" sentiment onto the 1.25x3.25 and 1.75x3.75" panels (for horizontal cards) and add with foam adhesive. Tuck the shell applique behind the sentiment and finish with sequins. Add the .75x6.25 strip, inner sentiment and fussy-cut shell to the inside of the card.



Set C: 5x7" Cards

Assembly steps: Nest the 1.75x6.75" panel onto the 2x7" panel. Remove each laser cut shell from the square and adhere to the smaller panel, as shown. Add to the left edge of the folded card base. Nest the 2.75x6" Print onto the 3x6.25" panel and wrap with your choice of ribbon(s). Adhere to the right side of the card, centered top to bottom. Nest the 1.5x3" sentiment onto the 1.75x3.25" panel and add to the card with foam adhesive. Adhere the 4th shell and inner sentiment to the inside of the card.
