Materials and Tools:

- Reef CS® Page Kit
- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Accordion Pocket File
- Adhesive
- Tape
- Foam Adhesive Tape
- 3x14" CS® Grid Ruler
- Scissors
- CS® Bookbinding Glue
- Needle-tipped Glue Applicator
- Staples and Stapler
- Crop-A-Dile or Hole Punch
- Corner Chomper or Corner Rounding Punch
- Slot Punch (Optional)
- Waxed Thread or Cord (Optional)

LB = Left Base Page
RB = Right Base Page

Measurement Conversions:

.25 = 1/4"
 .5 = 1/2"
 .75 = 3/4"

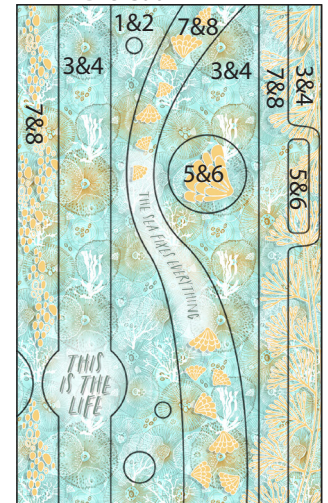
Preparation:

Trim the papers and printed cutaparts as indicated by the written instructions. While trimming, distribute the pieces to a pile or file designated for each double page spread as referenced in the diagram.

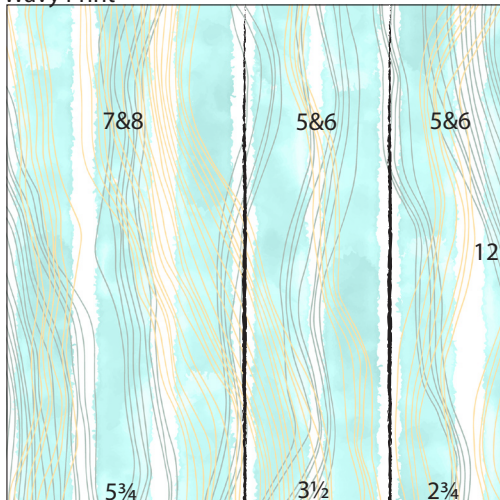
1. Trim approximately 1/8" from each long edge of the printed die cut to create a 12" piece and to release the diecut strips from the parent sheet.

Distribute the pieces to the assigned pocket or pile as indicated.

12x12 Die Cut



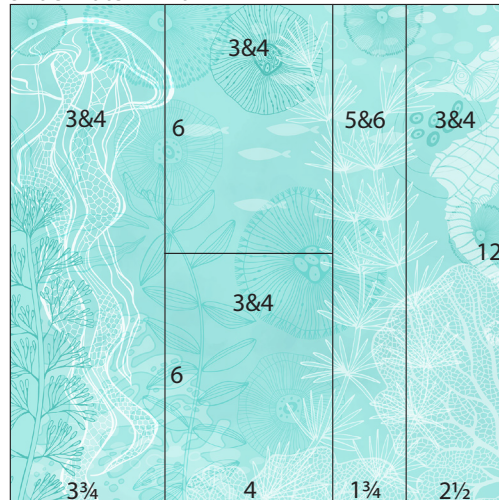
Wavy Print



2. Use a grid ruler to help tear the Wavy Print into sections as shown in the image.

Alternatively, place the print into the trimmer with the stripes running vertically and cut at 9.25 and 5.75".

Underwater Print

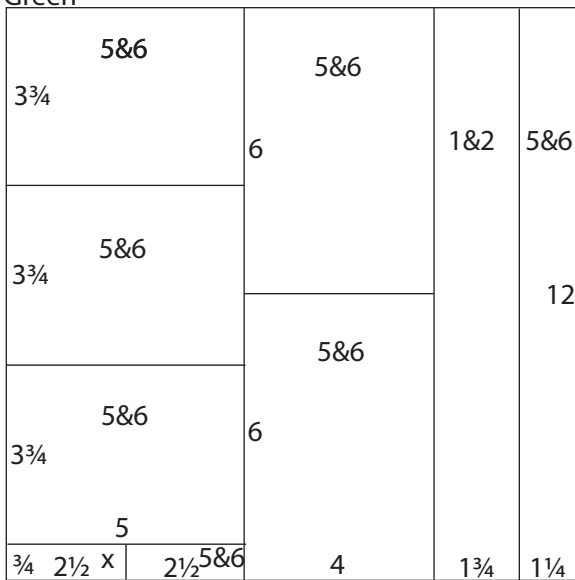


3. Trim one Underwater Print at 9.5, 7.75 and 3.75".

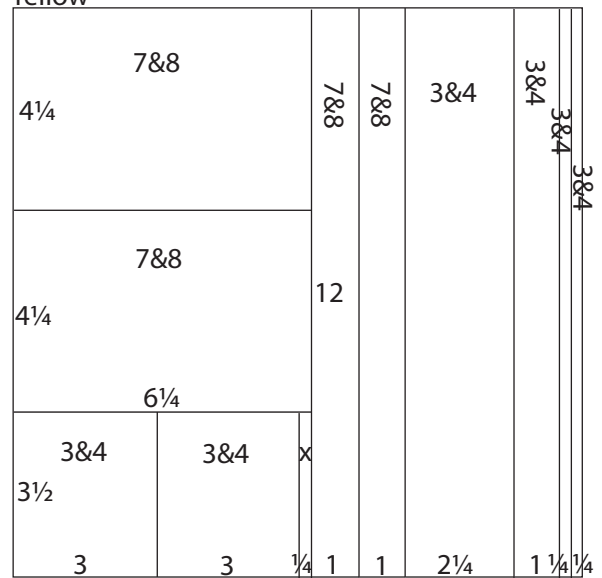
Cut the 4x12 at 6".



Green



Yellow



- Cut one Green at 10.75, 9 and 5".

Rotate and trim the 5x12 at 11.25, 7.5 and 3.75".

Cut the .75x5 at 2.5".

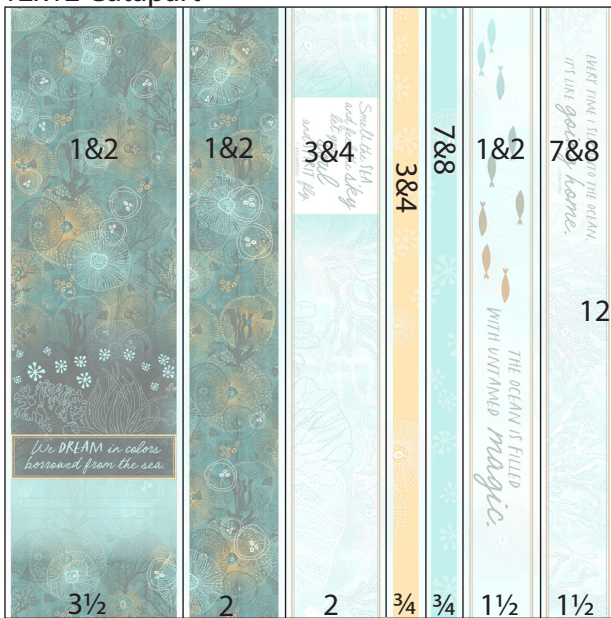
Trim the 4x12 at 6".

- Trim one Yellow at 11.75, 11.5, 10.5, 8.25, 7.25 and 6.25".

Cut the 6.25x12 at 8.5 and 4.25".

Trim the 3.5x6.25 at 6 and 3".

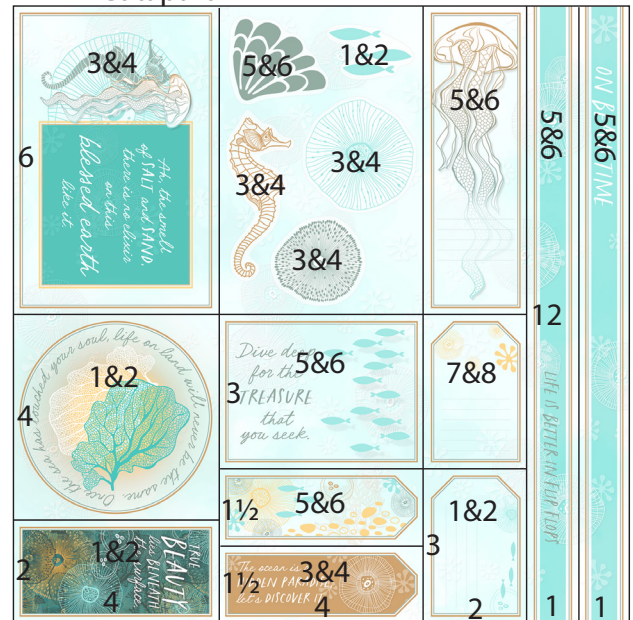
12x12 Cutpart



- Remove approximately 1/8" from the perimeter of the cutpart, using the intersecting marks on each corner as a cutting guide.

Cut at 10.5, 9, 8.25, 7.5, 5.5 and 3.5".

12x12 Cutpart



- Remove approximately 1/8" from the perimeter of the cutpart, using the intersecting marks on each corner as a cutting guide.

Trim at 11, 10, 8 and 4".

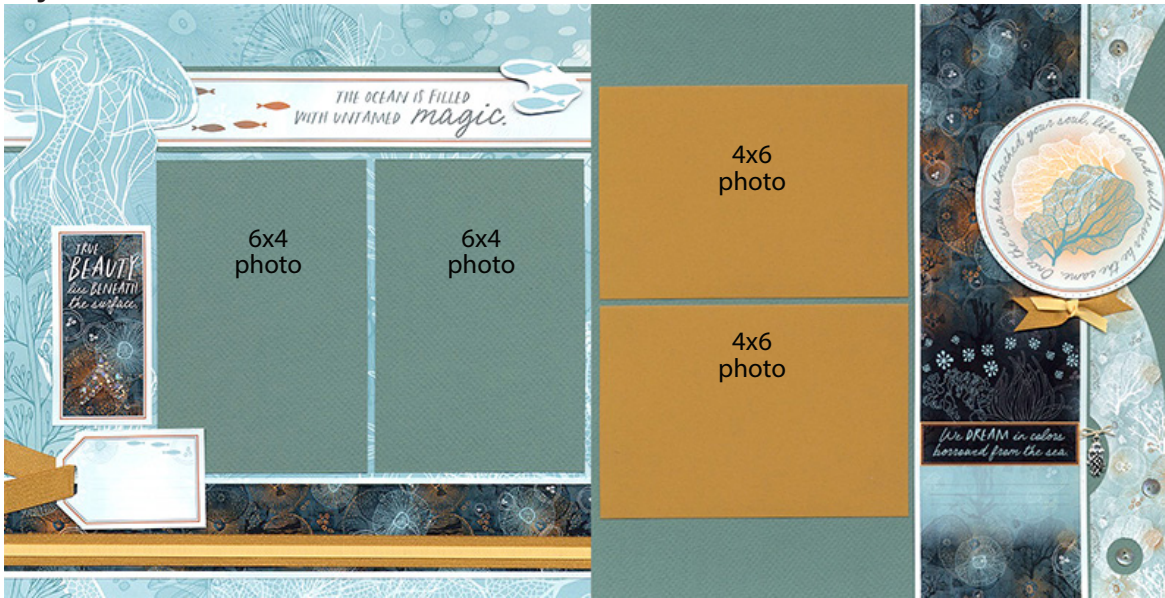
Rotate and cut one 4x12 at 10 and 6".

Trim one 4x12 at 10.5, 9 and 6".

Cut the 2x12 at 9 and 6".

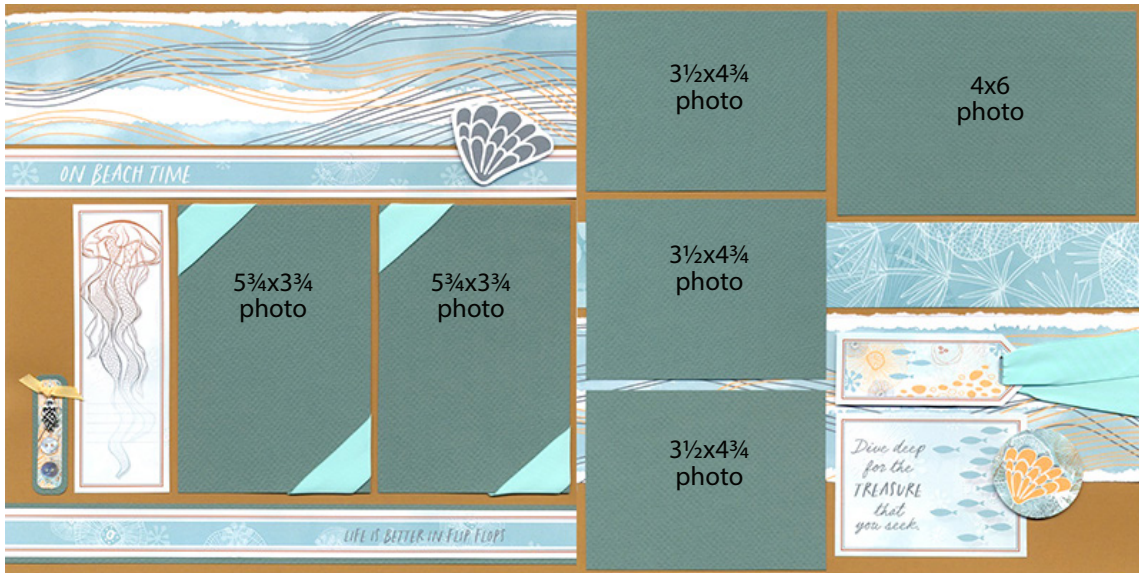

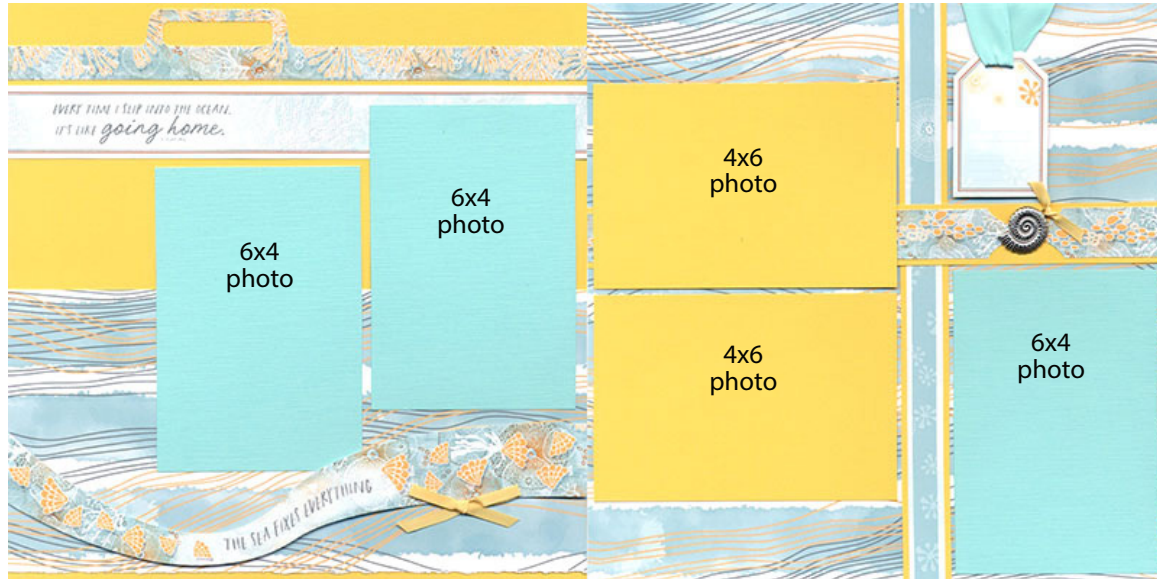
