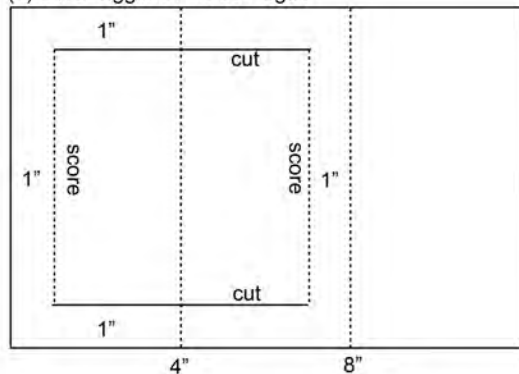
Project Kit:

- (2) 10x10" Grey Outside Cover Wraps
- (4) 8x12" Eggshell Inside Pages
- (2) 8x9.5" Eggshell Inside Pages
- 6.75x6.75" Matte Metallic Red Cover Panel
- 6x6" Black Cover Panel
- 5.75x5.75" Eggshell Cover Panel
- (2) 8.125x8.125 Matte Board Covers
- (2) Yards Waxed Linen Thread
- 1 Yard 5/8" Black Grosgrain Ribbon Closure

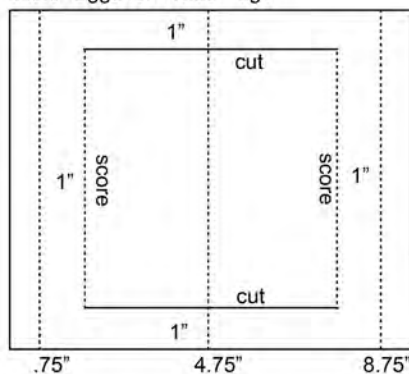
Tools and Materials:

- Pencil
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat
- Grid Ruler
- Needle
- Scissors
- Bone Folder
- CS® Bookbinding Glue
- Foam Brush
- Score-Pal®
- Paper Piercing Tool and Cork Board

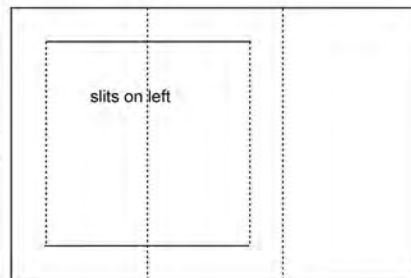
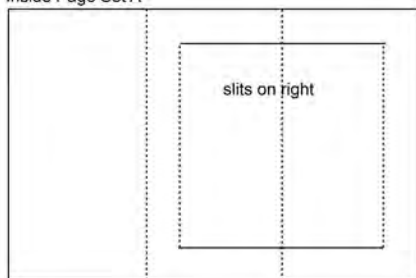


8x9.5" Eggshell Inside Page

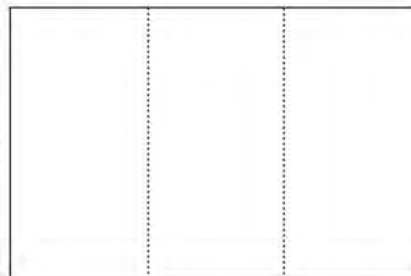
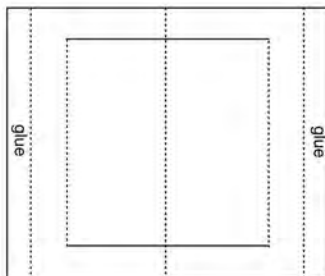


1. **Score** each 8x12" Eggshell Inside Page horizontally at 4 and 8". Score each 8x9.5" Eggshell Inside Page horizontally at .75, 4.75 and 8.75".

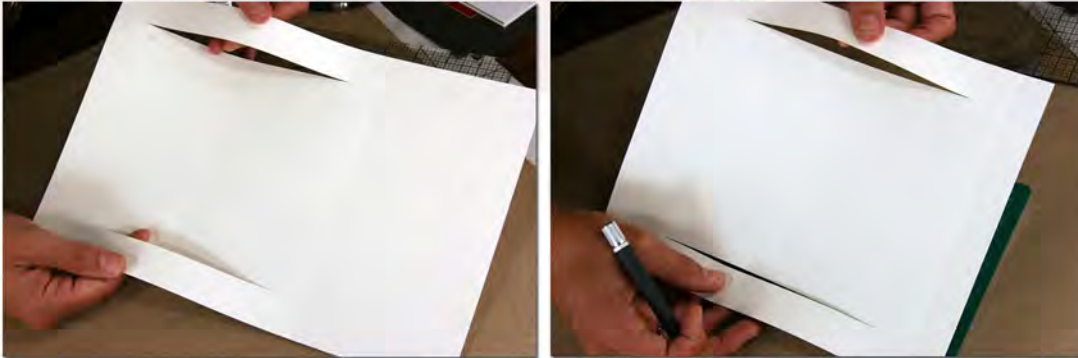
Inside Page Set A



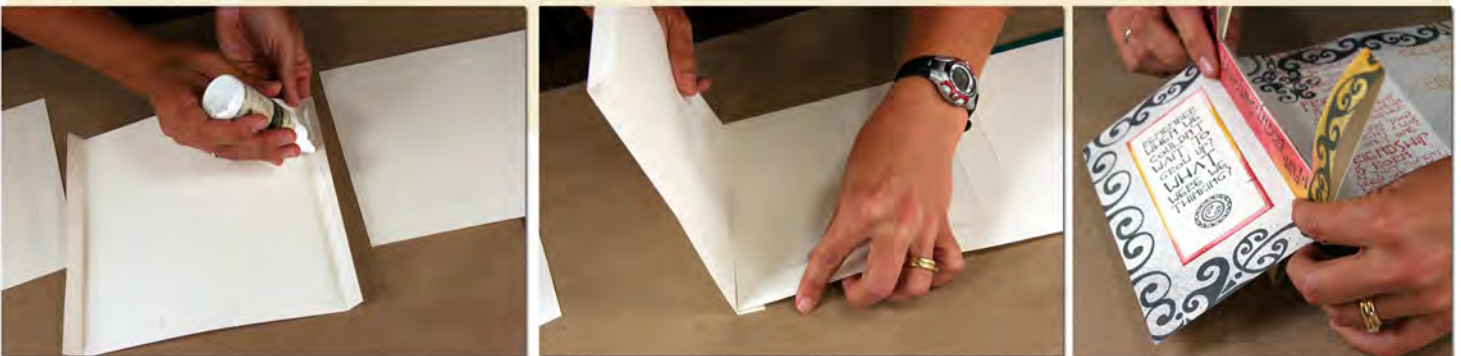
Inside Page Set B



2. Use a craft knife, ruler and cutting mat to cut a horizontal slot 1" from the top and bottom edges of two 8x12" Eggshell inside pages, starting 1" from the left edge, and stopping 1" before the second scoreline.
3. Cut a slot 1" from the top and bottom edges of one 8x9.5" inside page, starting 1" past the first scoreline and ending 1" prior to the third scoreline.
4. Add vertical scores to connect the two horizontal slits on each Inside Page.



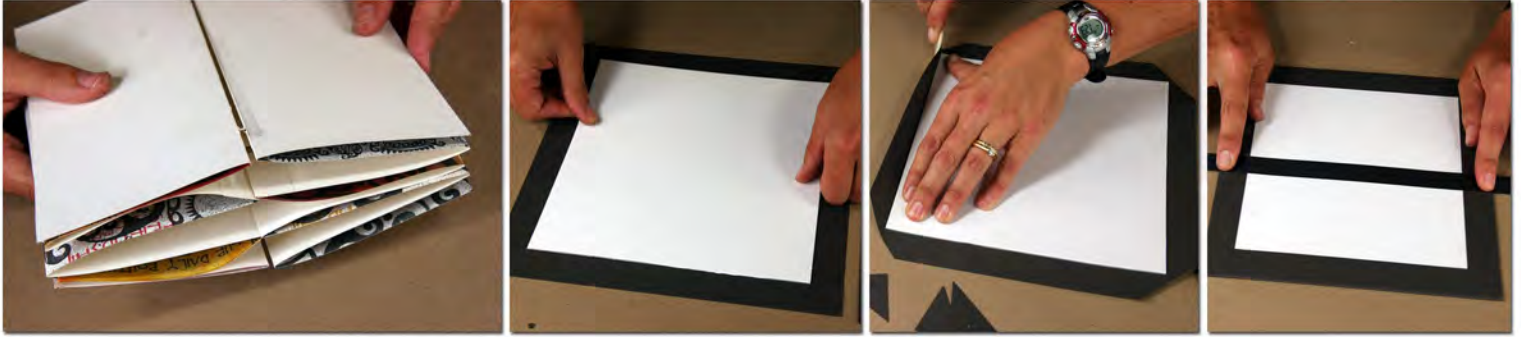
5. Sort the prepared inside pages into two groups. Set A includes two cut/scored 8x12" pages and one scored 8x9.5" page in the middle. Set B includes two 8x12" scored inside pages and one 8x9.5" cut/scored page in the middle. Working one area at a time, brush glue onto the .75" scored areas on the center pages and attach the 8x12" pages on left and right, as shown.
6. Decorate one side of each set of inside pages with stamped images, paint, mists, stencils, etc. Fold along all scorelines, reversing the direction of the folds to form an accordion. Fold in along the shorter scorelines to create windows.



7. Use a paper piercing tool and cork board to pierce a stitching hole 1" from the top and bottom edges of each valley fold on page sets A and B.
8. Thread a needle with waxed linen. Face the plain sides of the page sets back to back. Enter one bottom stitching hole and go through the corresponding stitching hole of the facing page. Stitch back through the pair of holes at the top. Tie waxed linen thread tails together in a square knot and trim the tails to approximately 1".
9. Repeat step 8 to attach each pair of stitching holes with thread.



10. **Fold** the stitched pages as shown, with the plain 4x8" panels facing out on each end.
11. **Glue** the matte board covers to the center of the 10x10" Grey Outside Cover Wraps.
12. **Trim** each paper corner at a 45 degree angle, being sure to leave at least 1/8" of paper extending beyond the tip of each corner. Wrap the paper flaps around the matte boards with a bone folder. Glue the flaps into place.
13. **Identify** the center of the black grosgrain ribbon and glue to the inside center of one matte board.



14. **Brush** glue onto the 4x8" flaps on the back of the inside page set. Attach to the inside of the wrapped matte board containing the ribbon.
15. **Apply** glue to the plain 4x8" flaps on the front of the inside page set, and attach the remaining outside cover.
16. **Stamp** or embellish the 5.75x5.75" Eggshell Cover Panel. Adhere to the Black and Red nesting panels and attach to the matte board cover.
