Materials and Tools:


- Riverbend CS® Card Kit
- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Accordion Pocket File
- ScorPal
- Adhesive
- Tape
- Foam Adhesive Tape
- **Measurement Conversions:** $.25 = \frac{1}{4}$ "

 $.5 = \frac{1}{2}$ "

 $.75 = \frac{3}{4}$ "

Preparation:

Trim the papers and cutaparts into sections as indicated by the detailed instructions. While trimming, distribute the pieces to a pile or file designated for each card set as referenced in the diagram. If there is an arrow on the paper trimming diagram, make sure the paper grain dips easily in the same direction as the arrow when placing the paper into the trimmer.



Trim one Dk. Green, Teal, Lt. Green and Aqua at 11.25 and 7".


Rotate and cut the 7x12 at 10".

Trim the 2x7 at 4.25". Cut the 4.25x12 at 11".

Score each 7x10 horizontally at 2.5 and 7.5".

Score each 4.25x11 at 2.75 and 8.25".

Cut one Dk. Green, Teal, Lt. Green and Agua at 11.5, 9 and 6.25".

Rotate and trim the 6.25x12 at 9".


Cut the 3x6.25 at 6 and 3.25".

Trim the 2.75x12 at 6".

Cut the 2.5x12 at 8 and 4".

Score each 6.25x9 horizontally at 3". Flip the paper bottom to top and score at 6".






3. Trim one White Linen at 9.5 and 4.75".


Cut each 4.75x12 at 8 and 4".

Trim the 2.5x12 at 11.5 and 5.75".

Place each 4x4.75" piece into the ScorPal texture side facing down; score horizontally at 4.25".



5. Trim one Print at 9 and 6.75". Cut the 6.75x12 at 11.25, 9, 6.75, 4.5 and 2.25". Trim the 2.25x12 at 6.75". Cut the 3x12 at 11, 8.25, 5.5 and 2.75".




4. Cut one White Linen at 8 and 4".

Trim two 4x12 strips at 6".

Cut one 4x12 at 9.5 and 4.75".

Score each 4x6 horizontally at .5 and 5.5".


Place each 4x4.75 into the ScorPal texture side facing down; score horizontally at 4.25".



6. Cut one Print at 9.75, 7.5 and 3.75". Trim each 3.75x12 at 9, 6.75, 4.5 and 2.25". Cut each 2.25x12 at 6.75".

7. Remove the perimeter of the Cutapart by trimming along the corner guidelines.


Trim at 11.75, 9.25, 6.75 and 3.75".

Rotate and cut the 3.75x12 at 11.25, 10.5, 9.75, 9, 6.75, 4.5 and 2.25".

Trim the 3x12 at 9, 6 and 3".

Cut each 2.5x12 at 11, 8.25, 5.5 and 2.75".

8. Remove the perimeter of the Cutapart by trimming along the corner guidelines.

Cut one Cutapart at 8 and 4".

Trim two 4x12 strips at 10.5 and 5.25".

Cut each 1.5x4 at 2".

Trim one 4x12 at 10.25, 8.5, 6.75 and 5".

Remove the four circles with scissors, a punch, or cutting die.



Set A: 41/4x51/2" Cards

Assembly steps: Add the 2.5x4" panels to the outer left and right card flaps and nest with a 2.25x3.75" printed panel. Staple ribbon onto the cutapart sentiment or wrap with jute; nest onto the 2.5x4" panel. Adhere water drop stickers to the cutapart with the tip of a craft knife. Adhere the sentiment to the left flap of the card. Center the inner sentiment onto the inside of the card and top with a fish cutout.

Set B: 41/2x61/4" Cards

Assembly steps: Glue three long sequins to the bottom of a 2.75x6" panel and trim excess sequin from the edge after glue cures. Nest the panel onto the left flap of the accordion folded card base. Add a second 2.75x6" panel to the right flap of the card base. Wrap ribbon around the 2.5x2.75" cutapart, if desired, and nest onto a 2.75x3 print and 3x3.25" panel. Adhere the panel to the upper right side of the front card panel, exactly 1.5" from the left edge, being aware of adhesive placement. (This will make a 4.5" wide card to fit perfectly into the envelope.) Nest the 2.5x2.75" Cutapart sentiment onto a 2.75x3" panel. Open the first flap of the card, and place the nested inner sentiment face down and centered with the outer sentiment. Apply adhesive to the right side of the panel and close the right card flap to secure the panel in the correct spot. Add the 1.5x2" cutapart to the inside left panel.








For cards 3 and 4, nest a cutapart circle onto a corrugated tag, top with ribbon, and add to the front of the card, as shown.








Set C: 5x7" Cards












Steps to make shutter mechanism:

- 1. Center the inner sentiment cutapart onto a 4x6" White panel and trace around it with a pencil.
- 2. Remove the square shape with a ruler, craft knife, and cutting mat. Trace the opening onto the remaining panels and remove the windows in the same manner. Alternatively, use a square die cut or punch to create a 3" window.
- 3. Place one 4x4.75" shutter horizontally on your work surface with the bump of the score facing down. Measure and mark a spot 2.5" from the non-scored edge, centered top to bottom at 2".
- 4. Cut from the non-scored corners to the marked spot in the center to remove a triangular shape. Using the first shutter as a template, trace the angled shape onto the remaining shutters and cut along the marked lines with scissors. This can be done two at a time.
- 5. Clip a small triangle from the outside tip of each shutter.
- 6. Adhere the inner cutapart to the inside of the gate folded card base, centered from top to bottom.
- 7. Fold along the score lines of the window panel. Apply adhesive to the 1/2" tabs and center the opening over the cutapart and onto the center of the card.
- 8. Fold along the score lines of two prepared 4x4.75" shutters with the bump of the score on the inside of the fold to create a 1/2" tab. Slide one shutter behind the window of the White panel, allowing the 1/2" tab to catch on the left side of the window.
- 9. Slide the other shutter behind the right side of the panel. Be sure one shutter is on top and one shutter on the bottom. Apply glue to the 1/2" tab of each shutter and close the card.
- 10. Allow the glue to cure and open the gate fold to slide the shutter and reveal the sentiment inside. Add the inner sentiment to the bottom of the frame.
