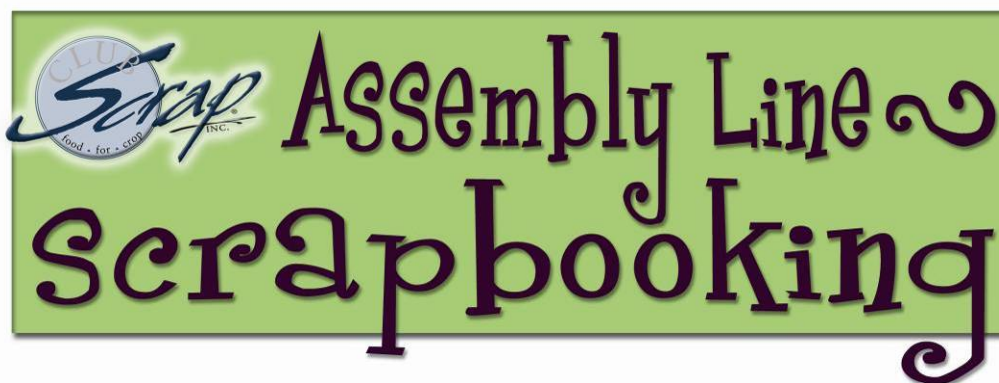

Heart to Heart Greetings to Go

Materials:

Preparation:

Trim out the cutaparts along the pre-printed cutting guidelines with a trimmer or ruler and craft knife. Fold all cards along pre-scored lines. Carefully align card edges before reinforcing folds with bone folder.

There are two Greetings to Go options for this collection. Whether you have the Brights or Vintage option, we'll make each card twice, two each of three smaller cards, and two each of three larger cards for a total of twelve.



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Card #1 and #2



- ☐ Oval Die Cut Card with Die Cut and Inner Panels
- ☐ Cutaparts: "Happy Valentine's Day" and "I Love You"
- ☐ Dry Embossing Tool
- ☐ Watercolor Pencils
- ☐ Watercolor Crayons
- ☐ Waterbrush
- ☐ Score-it Board or Cushioned Surface

1. Color the outside of the heart with watercolor pencil; blend with a waterbrush.
2. Place the colored image on a cushioned surface. Go around the outer and inner edges of the element around the heart with the embossing tool. Turn the cutout over and go along the embossed lines to enhance the raised effect.
3. Splatter the card panel with watercolor.
4. Staple the "I Love You" greeting onto the die cut panel, edge the inner panels with ink and assemble the card

Card #3 and #4



- ☐ Oval Die Cut Card with Die Cut and Inner Panels
- ☐ Cutaparts: Be Mine and "Sweetheart" or "Be My Valentine"
- ☐ Paper Distressing Tool
- ☐ Watercolor Pencils
- ☐ Waterbrush

1. Color the heart stripes and blend colors with the waterbrush.
2. Distress the Cutapart, add ink to the edges and attach the corner between the die cut panel and card.



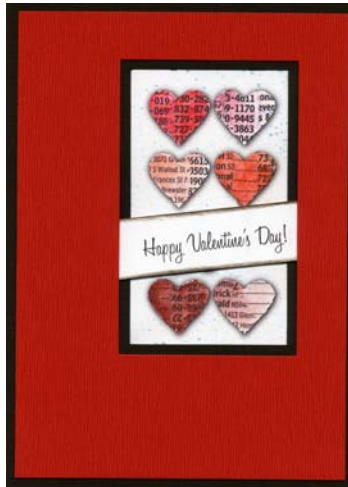
Card #5 and #6



- ☐ Oval Die Cut Card with Die Cut and Inner Panels
- ☐ Cutaparts: "Be Mine" and "Happy Valentine's Day!"
- ☐ Watercolor Pencils
- ☐ Waterbrush
- ☐ Craft Knife and Cutting Mat
- ☐ Foam Tape

1. Color the heart with watercolor pencils as desired and blend.
2. Remove the small heart shape from the Cutapart with a craft knife and cutting mat. For best results, use a sharp blade.
3. Temporarily place the Cutapart onto the inner panel and mark where the heart opening will be. Shade that area of the panel with a dark watercolor and attach the Cutapart to the panel.
4. Layer the trimmed heart onto the card with foam tape.

Card #7 and #8



- ☐ Square Die Cut Card with Die Cut and Inner Panels
- ☐ Cutaparts: "Be Mine" (With Six Hearts) and "Happy Valentine's Day"
- ☐ Watercolor Pencils and Waterbrush

1. Color the hearts with various watercolor pencils; blend.
2. Attach the "Happy Valentine's Day" strip between the die cut card and die cut panel so that it is positioned at an angle, covering the "Be Mine" greeting beneath.



Card #9 and #10



- ☐ Square Die Cut Card with Die Cut and Inner Panels
- ☐ Cutaparts: "Roses are Red..." and "Happy Valentine's Day"
- ☐ Watercolor Pencils and Waterbrush
- ☐ Watercolor Crayons
- ☐ Dry Embossing Tool

1. Color the heart and the shadow around the outside of the square with watercolor pencils; blend.
2. Place the cutpart on a cushioned surface and go around the perimeter of the square and the heart image with a dry embossing tool. Turn the piece over, and outline around the raised lines with the embossing tool.
3. Splatter the cutout with watercolors and layer onto the inside panel.
4. Attach the "Happy Valentine's Day" Cutpart between the two die cuts at an angle so that the greeting covers the heart inside the card.

Card #11 and #12



- ☐ Square Die Cut Card with Die Cut and Inner Panels
- ☐ Cutaparts: "Be Mine" and "Happy Valentine's Day"
- ☐ Watercolor Pencils and Waterbrush
- ☐ Craft Knife and Cutting Mat

1. Color the heart with watercolor pencils; blend. Remove the image from the Cutpart with a craft knife and cutting mat.
2. Reattach the cut image to the card with foam tape. Add watercolor splatter, if desired.
