

## Perpetual Desk Calendar

Never forget another special occasion again! Keep this handy desk calendar nearby and simply flip the page for your monthly reminder of all birthdays, anniversaries and other annual events. Banish the "belated" birthdays!

## kit ingredients:

(12) 7x8" Sky Printed Calendar Pages
12x10-1/2" Olive Outside Wrap
5-1/4x10-1/2" Dark Blue Outside Wrap
7x9" Sky Outside Riser Wrap
(2) 7-3/8x8-1/4" Dark Blue Inside Covers
4-1/4x6-1/4" Teal Printed Matte
(2) 1-1/2" Binder Rings

5x7" Bookboard Platform
(2) 8-1/2x7-1/2" Bookboard (

(2) 8-1/2x7-1/2" Bookboard Covers

18" White Twill Closure

## tools & supplies:

CS® Bookbinding Glue
Bone Folder
Scissors
CS® Grid Ruler
Cropadile or Screw Punch
UM Stamps and Embellishments

One: Using a pencil, measure and mark one 7x8" Sky Calendar Page I" from the left and right edges, and 3/4" from the top edge. Punch a 1/4" hole at the intersecting marks. Use the first page as a template to punch the remaining calendar pages. Erase pencil marks.

WO: Center one calendar page onto one 8-1/2x7-1/2" Bookboard Cover. Mark the location of the holes with a pencil and punch. Repeat for the second Bookboard Cover.

board covers onto the Olive and Dark Blue Outside Wraps, as shown. Keep in mind that the punched holes in the bookboard face the spine, and that the gutter between the two boards will be 1/4". Work carefully while gluing the pieces into place.

cover and position onto the left bookboard cover and position onto the 12x10-1/2" Olive Outside Wrap, I" from the left edge and centered from top to bottom.

the remaining bookboard cover 3-1/4" from the hole punched edge. (This would be a great time to use your 8x8" Grid Ruler!)

Marked area and place onto the Olive wrap, leaving 1/4" space between the two covers. Use the ruler to ensure that the covers are level and that the spacing is accurate.


**Seven:** Turn the cover over and apply glue to the remaining exposed bookboard.

Outside Wrap onto the glued area against the edge of the Olive wrap. Burnish the cover papers onto the board with a bone folder.

angle at each corner, leaving at least 1/8" of paper beyond the tip of the corner.























flaps around the bookboard, using a bone folder to make straight creases.






















**eleven:** Glue all flaps into place. Tuck in the excess paper at each corner to make clean folds.

**twelve:** Transfer the location of the punched holes through the outside cover wrap with a sharp object. Push the cover paper down into the punched holes with a pencil.

**thirteen:** Cut the 18" White Twill in half with a scissors. Glue a piece of twill to the right and left edges of the wrapped book cover.

3/8x8-1/4" Dark Blue Inside Covers and position on the inside of the wrapped cover, aligned with the inside edge of the bookboard. Transfer the location of the punched holes through the inside covers and use a pencil to push the paper into the holes.

form onto the center of the 7x9" Sky Outside Riser Wrap. Cut the corners at a 45-degree angle, wrap paper flaps, and glue into place.

**SIXICON:** Turn the covered platform over and adhere the 4-1/4x6-1/4" Teal Printed Matte onto the center of the right side.

**Seventeen:** Glue the platform to the Olive/Blue side of the wrapped cover.

**eighteen:** Thread the binder rings through the punched holes and add the twelve calendar pages. Pinch the rings together.

**nineteen:** Tie the twill ribbon tails together to hold the calendar in a triangular position for desktop display. Embellish and decorate the cover and calendar pages as you wish!



bonus pocket!









Trim two 3-1/2x9" pieces of Olive Plain. Score each piece I" from the short edges and I" from one long edge.

**two:** Snip the scored corners from the pocket paper to create three flaps.

**Three:** Using the grid ruler as a folding guide, wrap the bottom flap and side tab around the ruler to create an 1/8" deep pocket. Glue the flaps into place and repeat for the other side of the pocket.

**FOUR:** Glue the U-shaped flaps to the inside covers of the desktop calendar.

Load the pockets with memorabilia, pre-made cards, postage stamps or any other trinket you have on hand!
