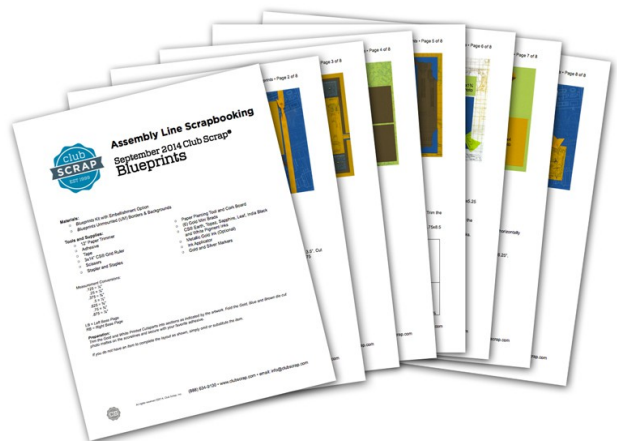
## Special Edition Make 'n Take

Hi, and thanks for stopping by to learn more about Club Scrap! You'll find the instructions below to assemble all three theme choices for our make 'n take.

Our method of efficient scrapbooking was developed in 2005, and we've been helping people accomplish their scrapbooking goals ever since.

Club Scrap members receive something very unique with each monthly shipment . . . a downloadable set of page assembly instructions custom designed to help them utilize every last scrap of paper included in the box. (Well, almost. There may be a few minuscule scraps here and there.) Our kit club pages also come fully embellished with fibers, photo mats, brads, eyelets, cutaparts, etc.

Your basic page kit was created to help you take our efficient method for a spin. The three layouts below contain the same number of papers cut in the same way, and each spread is essentially identical yet unique in appearance. You can also recycle the same instructions and substitute coordinating papers from your existing stash. It's a great value!



You'll need a [12" paper trimmer](#) and adhesive. We prefer to use a guillotine-style trimmer because of the thickness of our papers and the efficiency/accuracy it provides. Follow the paper trimming instructions step by step, keeping in mind that sometimes a paper is trimmed twice. If directed to "trim at 9 and 5", cut the paper first at 9", slide the paper down to 5", and make a second cut. If you haven't measured something in a decade or two, we try to keep those cuts rounded to the nearest quarter inch. You will also need to pay attention to paper direction . . . we'll tell you if the paper is placed into the trimmer horizontally or vertically.

Once you've finished preparing the required papers, simply arrange and adhere the pieces on the layout as shown. Incorporate photos, coordinating fibers, stickers or other embellishments from your stash to complete the page. The measurement noted on each photo mat indicates the size of the photo required for that spot.

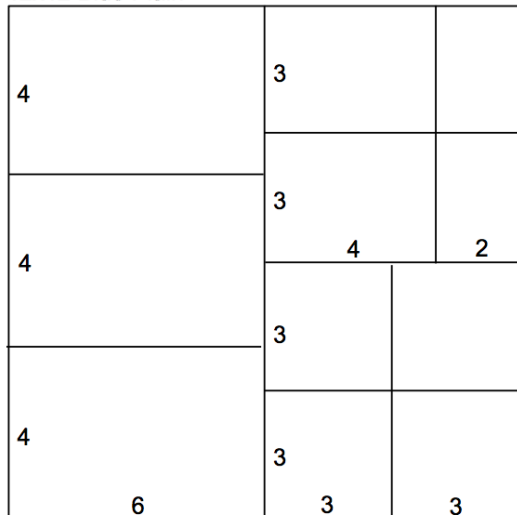


**Moroccan Spice Page Kit**

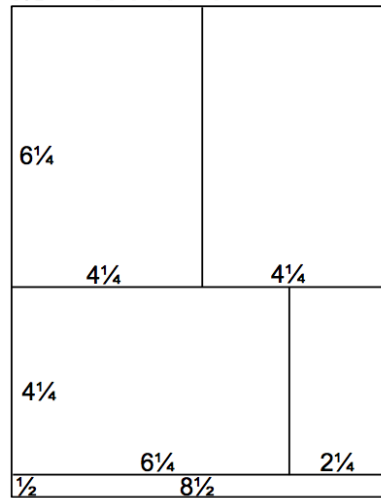


- (2) 12x12 Ivory Prints (Left Base/Right Base)
  - 12x12 Blue Plain
  - 8.5x11 Caramel Plain
1. Trim the 12x12 Blue Plain at 6". Cut one 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4". Trim the other 6x12 horizontally at 9, 6 and 3". Cut two 3x6 strips horizontally at 4". Trim two 3x6 strips at 3".
  2. Cut the 8.5x11 Caramel Plain horizontally at 10.5 and 6.25". Trim the 6.25x8.5 horizontally at 4.25". Cut the 4.25x8.5 horizontally at 6.25".

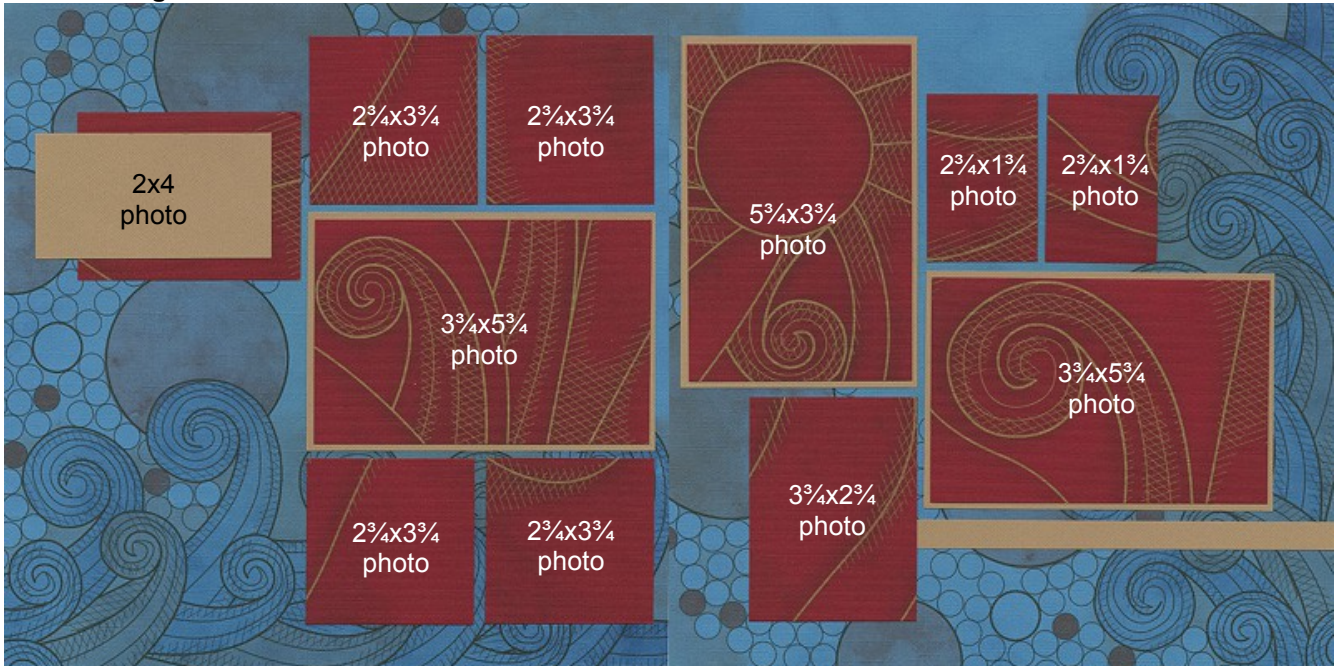
12x12 Blue Plain



8 1/2 x 11 Caramel Plain

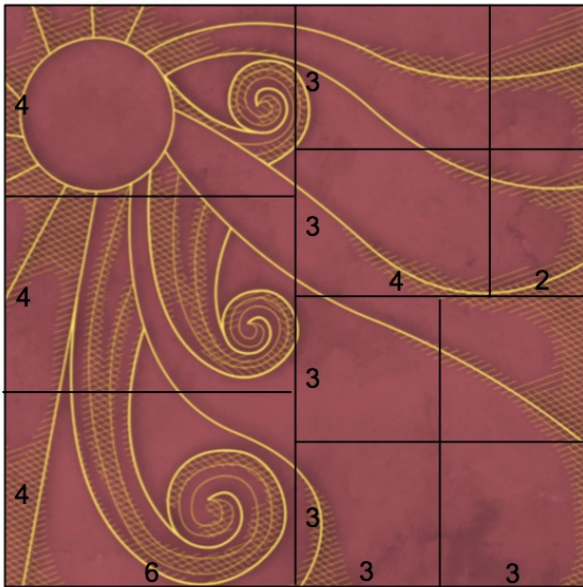


**Reunion Page Kit**

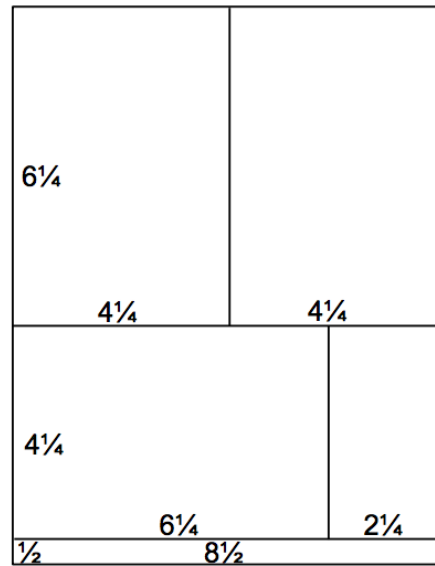


- (2) 12x12 Blue Prints (Left Base/Right Base)
  - 12x12 Red Print
  - 8.5x11 Tan Plain
1. Trim the 12x12 Red Print at 6". Cut one 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4". Trim the other 6x12 horizontally at 9, 6 and 3". Cut two 3x6 strips horizontally at 4". Trim two 3x6 strips at 3".
  2. Cut the 8.5x11 Tan Plain horizontally at 10.5 and 6.25". Trim the 6.25x8.5 horizontally at 4.25". Cut the 4.25x8.5 horizontally at 6.25".

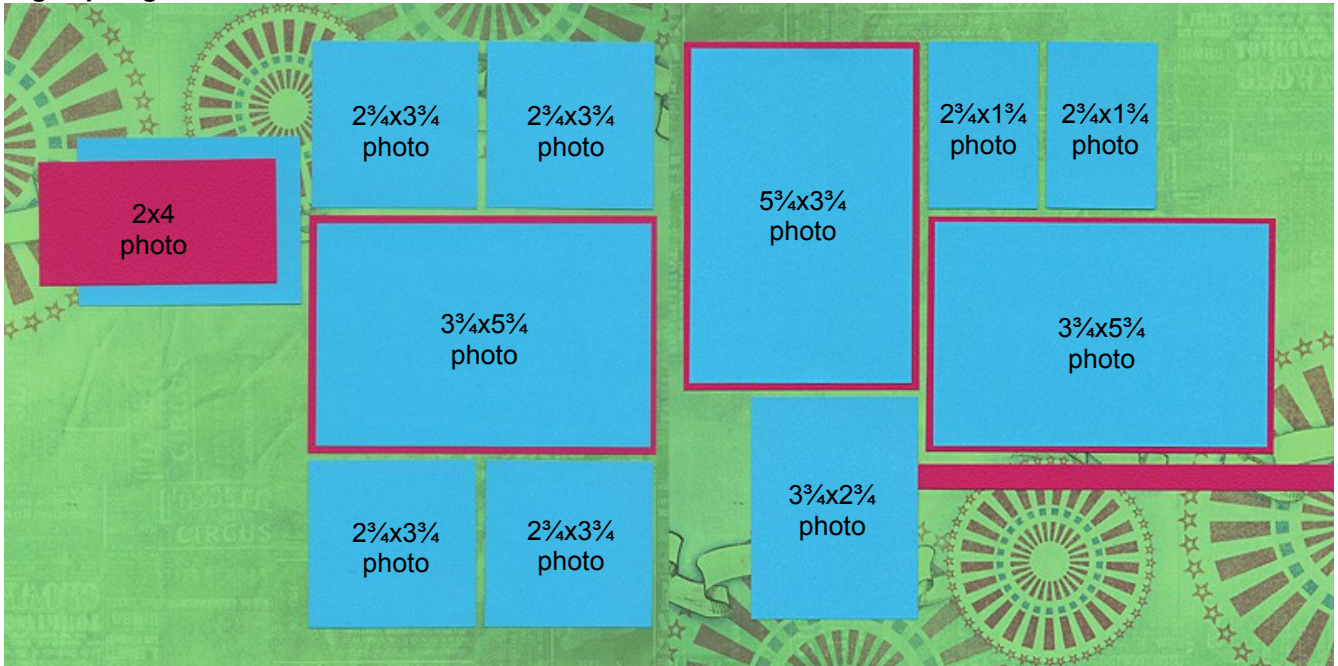
12x12 Red Print



8 1/2 x 11 Tan Plain



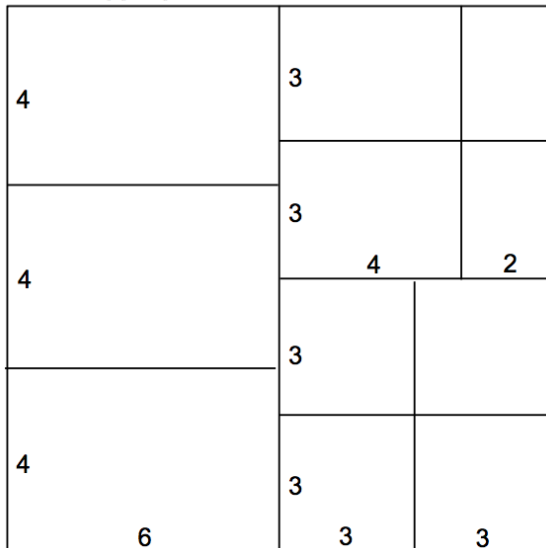
**Big Top Page Kit**



- (2) 12x12 Green Prints (Left Base/Right Base)
- 12x12 Blue Plain
- 8.5x11 Pink Plain

1. Trim the 12x12 Blue Plain at 6". Cut one 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4". Trim the other 6x12 horizontally at 9, 6 and 3". Cut two 3x6 strips horizontally at 4". Trim two 3x6 strips at 3".
2. Cut the 8.5x11 Pink Plain horizontally at 10.5 and 6.25". Trim the 6.25x8.5 horizontally at 4.25". Cut the 4.25x8.5 horizontally at 6.25".
