# Set A: 4-5/8 x 3-3/8 Rose Cards with Lilac Panels

#### Card #1



- □ Folded Rose Card
- □ Lilac Panel
- ☐ Green Perforated Die Cuts
- □ Printed Grosgrain Ribbon
- □ Paper Distressing Tool
- ☐ Brown Ink

- 1. Distress the edges of the Green die cut with the mini tool.
- 2. Ink edges of the panel, card, and "Happy Anniversary" with brown ink.
- 3. Trim ribbon and wrap ends around to the back of the Lilac panel.

- ☐ Green, Lilac, Rose and Tan Perforated Die Cuts
- □ Foam Adhesive
- □ Brown Ink

- 1. Tear out two Green and one each of the Tan, Lilac, and Rose "Love" images from the die cut sheets.
- 2. Cut a Rose "L," a tan "O," a Green "V," and a Lilac "E" from the die cuts with a scissors. Ink edges with brown ink.
- 3. Adhere a Green "Love" die cut to a vertical Lilac Panel. Attach each letter to the top of the Green die cut with foam tape.
- 4. Write the word "Love" beneath the die cuts with a black pen.
- 5. Ink edges of Lilac panel and Rose card with brown and assemble the card.

- 1. Tear a Tan, Rose, and Green "rose" image from the perforated die cuts. Distress and ink edges.
- Attach the die cuts horizontally to the Lilac panel. Use the grid ruler to find the exact center of the panel. Trim the images that extend beyond the edges.
- 3. Tear a Lilac "Thinking of You" image from the die cuts; trim closely to the text and color edges with brown ink. Layer onto the card.

□ Paper Distressing Tool

- 1. Tear a Tan "rose" image and a Green "Thinking of You" from the perforated die cuts. Tear the bottom edge from the "Thinking of You" die cut. Distress and ink the edges. Attach to a vertical Lilac Panel.
- 2. Tie a bow with the rayon ribbon and attach with a Glue Line.
- 3. Tear the bottom edge of the Lilac Panel, ink edges and attach to card.

- 1. Trim the Lilac Panel to 2.5x3. Ink entire surface of panel with brown ink to reveal the paper texture.
- 2. Tear "Thanks" and "Thanks a Lot)" from the Green perforated Die Cuts. Ink edges and layer onto the Lilac Panel.
- 3. Attach the Lilac Panel vertically onto the folded Rose card and embellish with paper flowers.

# Set B: 3-7/8 x 9-1/4 Green Cards with Tan Panels



- □ Folded Green Card
  - Tan Panel
- ☐ Green and Lilac Perforated Die Cuts
- □ Rayon Ribbon
- □ Brown Ink
- □ Glue Lines
- Scissors

- 1. Tear the "You're the Best" image from the Green and Lilac perforated die cuts.
- 2. Cut the flower image from the Lilac die cut, ink edges, and layer over the flower image on the Green die cut.
- 3. Place the layered die cut vertically onto the upper center of the Tan panel.
- 4. Tie the rayon ribbon into a bow and attach beneath the die cut with a Glue Line.
- 5. Ink edges of Tan Panel and Green card; assemble.

- □ Paper Distressing Tool
- 1. Tear "You're Beautiful" from the Green, Rose and Lilac die cuts. Distress and ink edges with brown ink.
- 2. Layer the three die cuts horizontally along the bottom edge of a Tan panel. Trim the portion of the die cuts that extend beyond the edge of the panel.
- 3. Tie a piece of grosgrain ribbon into a bow and attach to the left side of the Tan panel.
- 4. Ink edges of Tan panel and Green card; assemble.

- 1. Tear "Happy Birthday" from the Lilac die cuts; ink flowers with plum wine and pine ink. Distress edges and ink with plum wine. Layer horizontally onto the lower right corner of the Tan Panel.
- 2. Tie a bow with multi-colored fiber and wrap horizontally around the Tan panel. Ink all edges and assemble the card.



| Folded Green Card         |
|---------------------------|
| Tan Panel                 |
| Green Perforated Die Cuts |
| Grosgrain Ribbon          |
| Plum Wine Ink             |
| Foam Adhesive             |

- 1. Tear "Get Well Soon" from the Green die cuts; ink edges with plum.
- 2. Rub plum wine ink over entire surface of Tan panel to reveal the texture of the paper; ink edges.
- 3. Wrap a length of grosgrain ribbon around the top half of the vertical Tan panel; secure edges at the back and layer onto the Green card.
- 4. Attach the "Get Well Soon" die cut on the center of the ribbon with foam adhesive.

- □ Lilac and Rose Perforated Die Cuts
- Pine, Plum Wine and Bordeaux Ink

- 1. Tear "You're the Best" from the Rose die cuts; ink edges with bordeaux ink. Tear the entire row of roses from the Lilac die cuts; color edges with pine ink.
- 2. Layer the strip of Lilac roses vertically onto the left side of a Tan panel.
- 3. Attach the "You're the Best" die cut to the upper half the panel. Ink edges of panel and card. Assemble.

# Set C: 5x7 Lilac Cards with Green Panels

#### Card #1



- □ Folded Lilac Card
- □ Green Panel
- □ Perforated Die Cuts
- □ Plum Wine and Pine Ink

- 1. Tear out the Lilac "lily" image, the Tan "rose" image and the Rose "Happy Anniversary" from the perforated die cuts. Ink edges with plum.
- 2. Cut a Tan "L," Rose "O," Lilac "V" and Green "E" from the same die cuts you used earlier for the "Love" card in Set A. Ink edges with plum.
- 3. Attach all die cuts to the Green panel as shown. Attach the word "love" with foam tape. Use the grid ruler to center and align lettering.
- 4. Ink Green panel with Pine ink and the Lilac card with plum wine ink; assemble.

- 1. Tear "Thanks for Being You" from the Rose die cuts; ink with plum wine.
- 2. Twist a length of grosgrain ribbon and secure with a Glue Line. Attach to a vertical Green panel beneath the Rose die cut.
- 3. Ink edges of Green panel with pine ink, and the Lilac card with plum wine ink. Assemble the card.


- 1. Tear a pair of "Hi" images from the Tan, Green and Rose die cuts. Sponge brown ink onto the edges.
- 2. Attach the die cuts in a vertical row onto the right edge of the Lilac card.
- 3. Tear the right edge of a vertical Green panel, making it 2.75" wide. Ink edges with pine and layer onto the left side of the card.
- 4. Tear out the Rose "Miss U" image, sponge brown ink onto the edges, and layer onto the Green panel.
- 5. Ink edge of Lilac card with plum wine ink.

- Place grid ruler on an angle onto the upper half of a vertical Green panel.
  Use a pencil to mark along both edges of the ruler. Trim on the pencil
  lines. Set aside the 2" angled piece, and ink edges of remaining two
  pieces.
- 2. Layer the angled Green panels onto the upper and lower half of the Lilac panel.
- 3. Tear the Rose "Congratulations" from the die cuts, distress edges and ink with Bordeaux.
- 4. Staple two short folded lengths of grosgrain ribbon onto the upper left and lower right corners of the Rose die cut. Layer at an angle into the opening between the two Green panels.

- 1. Tear the Rose "Happy Birthday" image from the die cuts; ink edges with bordeaux.
- 2. Rub pine ink onto the entire surface of the 2" angled Green panel, ink edges, and layer onto the upper half of a vertical Green panel. Attach the Rose die cut to the Green strip. Ink edges of Green panel and Lilac card with pine ink; assemble the card.
