PATTERN PREP

PURCHASE & DOWNLOAD

- The pattern is available as a DIGITAL PDF DOWNLOAD for ease and accessibility on my website.
- SCAN the QR Code on the right.
- This pattern includes all of the instructions and diagrams we will be using in class.
- Download pattern on your laptop/tablet and bring your laptop/tablet to class in order to reference the pattern.
- PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE PATTERN BEFORE PRINTING.

PRINTING

- The pattern requires LEGAL SIZE PAPER (8.5x14)
- There are TWO pattern options available for you to choose from: WITH color indication and WITHOUT color indication boxes. YOU ONLY NEED TO PRINT ONE.
- Print at 100% (NOT "Fit to page") and be sure to print SINGLE SIDED.
- You are welcome to print the entire pattern. HOWEVER, if you would rather save on printing, you can download the pattern onto your laptop/tablet. Print only the pattern and reference the instructions/diagrams on your laptop.
- You only need to print the selected pattern paper pieces from which you will be working from.

CUTTING

- Once you have selected the pattern you will be sewing on for class, you will need to cut out all the pieces PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL TO CLASS.
- The pattern includes details on how to cut the pattern pieces out.
- If you are feeling optimistic, you can also GLUE together the pieces that have Glue Edges.
- The more prep work that takes place BEFORE class, the more sewing and instruction time we have.

FABRIC PREP

FABRIC SELECTION

- Fabric kits for this pattern are available on my website. Click on the QR Code for link.
- Kits will be available in December and will Ship January, 2022.
- However, you are welcome to select your own fabrics to coordinate with this pattern.

PRE STARCHING

- Whether you decide to select your own fabric or purchase the PATTERN KIT, I recommend starching your fabric ahead of time and giving the fabric a nice iron over. I personally do not prewash. But I do starch all the fabric before I start a sewing project. This will help make the sewing process more successful.
- You do not need to precut your fabric.

THREAD

- You are welcome to bring whatever thread you prefer.
- My preference is WONDERFIL DECOBOB in a gray shade.

SUPPLIES

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The Modern Quilt Guild provide some supplies. They will provide sewing machines for each quilter as well as group irons and cutting matts.
- I also recommend making a list of your personal sewing and personal items that make you comfortable and will ensure your sewing experience as enjoyable as possible.
- I recommend, if possible, for you to bring small individual-use items of the following:
 - IRONING:
 - Although ideally I would recommend a personal iron and ironing station at each of your sewing stations, due to electrical availability at Quilt Con, This is not possible. we will be sharing a few irons as a group.
 - Hence, please bring a hand-held edge press roller.
 - HANDSEWING (OPTIONAL): for the embroidery at the end. Hand sewing needle, thimble and black thread.
 - CUTTING:
 - A small cutting mat
 - Rotary cutter
 - Fabric scissors
 - Paper scissors
 - RULERS:
 - Ideally an "12in ADD a Quarter Ruler" OR (1) straight edge ruler AND (1) 6in Quilting Ruler

- MISC ITEMS:
 - lint Roller
 - Wonder clips
 - Pins
 - Seam Ripper
 - Tweezers (My favorite are Swiss Style by Tula Pink)
 - Elmers School Glue stick
 - Pencil
